Dear FedEx® Customer:

FedEx Express provides import and export clearance processing for FedEx shipments, offering guaranteed delivery in 24 hours to the United States.

FedEx Express customers in Aruba now have the option to bill U.S. clearance-related-fees to their FedEx Aruba account. In order to take advantage of this option, be sure to specify the account responsible for paying the duties and taxes on the shipping air waybill. These fees and charges will be reflected in your billing invoices as applicable to sender or third-party customers for shipments marked as "Bill Recipient" or "Third Party" for Duty/Tax charges.

Effective February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010, FedEx Express® account holders in Aruba may be subject to the following U.S. clearance-related fees, **whenever the "bill sender" option is selected**. For some dutiable shipments entering the US, the following fees may be imposed and applied by government agencies or your FedEx Customs broker. In addition, supplementary clearance service charges may apply based on specific customer requests.
