- FedEx SmartPost Parcel Select Lightweight
- Support for the 2012 Pricing Logic Change:
 - International dry ice surcharge
 - FedEx Ground® greater than 150 lbs.
 - Intra-Puerto Rico discounts
- ORM-D for FedEx Express only – Effective Jan. 2013, dangerous goods requirements are changing for the Other Regulated Materials for Domestic (ORM-D) class to comply with new regulations. Go to fedex.com/hazmat for more details on shipping requirements and regulations.

1	An IPD add a piece/shipment with a calculated commodity value < 0.01, or with override Tag 119 Total Customs Value included in the transaction, generates an error = "CI customs value cannot be left blank"	216790
2	A FedEx Ground domestic MPS with multi-occurrence tags in the transaction appears to print a TDTL containing a mixture of information on the label	231829
3	TD auto confirm feature is not working	234227
4	The package was shipped with 2600 = 1 or 4, the edit a package is not applied. (non-multiplier functionality)	234410
5	Upgrade from FSMS 10.0.9 to FSMS 11.0.5.36.01, ICTL controls are in alphabetical order instead of the pre-defined order	235070
