



Guide to Looking Up HS Codes

The Harmonized System Code (HS Code) is essential for import clearance into different countries/territories. It may go by different names depending on the shipment destination, e.g. Harmonized Tariff Schedule code (HTS) for the United States.



To ship to the U.S., entering the correct 10-digit H.T.S code helps identify and classify imported goods, avoiding potential customs delays, extra costs, and shipment holds.

FedEx offers following tools to assist customers in finding the right HS code, tailored to different shipping methods and preferences:

Tools	Description	Recommended for
<u>Global Trade Manager (GTM)</u>	This online tool can help you determine the correct HS code for your products. You can access it on the FedEx website and use it to search for the code by product description.	Any customers who need a straightforward and simple way to find HS codes.
<u>FedEx Ship Manager™ at fedex.com (FSM)</u>	As part of FedEx Ship Manager at fedex.com, you can look up the HS code by searching for relevant keywords during the shipment creation process.	Customers who use FedEx Ship Manager™ at fedex.com (FSM) for shipment creation.
<u>HS code lookup API</u>	HS Code Lookup API offers a way to integrate HS code searches directly into your own system or eCommerce website. This option provides flexibility and automation for businesses with specific technical needs.	Customers who use FedEx APIs to directly integrate with FedEx.
