

Goods and items excluded from domestic transport

These are goods, items and single elements which, because of their shape, weight or other characteristics, may pose a threat to FedEx employees or other shipments during pick-up and delivery operations. In order to ensure the highest quality of our services, such goods and products have been excluded from carriage.

List of goods and items excluded from domestic transport

Below is an updated list of goods and items that have been excluded from FedEx Domestic Services and TNT Domestic Services. FedEx does not provide services for such shipments and therefore its liability for carriage is excluded, regardless of whether the shipment has been accepted for carriage or not.

These goods and items are excluded from carriage, unless FedEx decides otherwise:

- a. Firearms, weaponry, ammunition, and their parts.
- b. 3-D printing machines designed, or that function exclusively, to manufacture firearms.
- c. Explosives, fireworks and other items of an incendiary or flammable nature.
- d. Items resembling a bomb, hand grenade or other explosive device. This includes, but is not limited to, inert products such as replicas, novelty items, training aids and works of art.
- e. Shipments originating from any country under a military export control license.
- f. Human corpses, human organs or body parts, human or animal embryos, cremated or disinterred human remains.
- g. Live animals, including insects and pets.
- h. Animal carcasses, dead animals, or animals that have been mounted.
- i. Plants and plant material, including cut flowers.
- j. Perishable foodstuffs, and foods and beverages requiring refrigeration or other environmental control.
- k. Pornography and/or obscene material.
- l. Money, including but not limited to cash and cash equivalents (e.g. negotiable instruments, endorsed stocks, bonds and cash letters), collectible coins and stamps.
- m. Hazardous waste, including, but not limited to, used hypodermic needles and/or syringes transported for sterilization, recycling, disposal or for any other purpose, or other medical waste, organic and industrial waste.
- n. Wet ice (frozen water).
- o. Counterfeit goods, including, but not limited to, goods under a trademark that is identical to or substantially indistinguishable from a registered trademark, without the approval or oversight of the registered trademark owner (also commonly referred to as “fake goods” or “knock-offs”).
- p. Marijuana, including marijuana intended for recreational or medicinal use and cannabidiol (CBD), any product that contains any amount of tetrahydrocannabinols (THC), and synthetic cannabinoids, hemp plants, hemp leaves, hemp oil, hemp seed oil, and CBD derived from hemp.
- q. Tobacco and tobacco products, including but not limited to cigarette, cigars, loose tobacco, smokeless tobacco, hookah or shisha.
- r. Electronic Cigarettes.
- s. Goods whose transport is subject to monitoring or additional requirements, in accordance with the laws in effect at the moment of their shipping, in particular the Act on the system of monitoring road and rail transport of goods and trade in heating fuels.
