


- Visit the FedEx Developer Resource Center (DRC): https://www.fedex.com/en-us/developer.html

 If you don't yet have these, you can create a login






Choose FedEx Web Services

After logging in, please click on FedEx Web Services




Get Production Credentials

Request Production Credentials


 Complete the page as below: select No, check the first box, select Corporate Developer, then click Continue








Request Production Credentials

- Now you can complete the contact information and registration page as shown (right)
- Please note, your phone number will need a '+' in front of the country code. The details on this page need to match those attached to your account number in the FedEx systems. If you have any issues, please double check your address details with your FedEx sales representative
- Then click Continue to complete the registration



Get your Production Credentials

- You will now see your Production Credentials on screen
- Please copy, paste and save your Production Authentication Key and Meter Number. Please note, a screenshot won't work here as we need to receive these details in «plain text» for activation
- You'll be sent an email containing your
 Production Password and the URL for the Production Environment. Please make sure you save this email



Enabling your Production Credentials

 Please speak to your FedEx sales representative to request activation/enablement of your Production Credentials. You'll need to provide them with your Production Authentication Key and Meter Number

 From here, FedEx Sales will create an internal "iSell" request, advising that you want to start shipping via the TPP



Validation and approval of shipping labels

1. First, create a test shipment in your production system to generate labels for FedEx to validate. Please make sure these are printed and scanned as PDF files. You'll need to create a shipment and labels for each of the FedEx services you're planning to use

2. Please cancel your test shipments after printing the labels

3. Email the labels to your FedEx sales representative to request label validation

4. FedEx validates/certifies the labels

5. FedEx will inform you and FedEx Sales if the labels have been validated (or not). If the label is validated, you're ready to go live

6. If the labels are not validated, please redo your label test shipments starting again at step 1.
