Value Added Services(1)(2)

You can customise your FedEx services to your needs (or the needs of your recipients) with value added services from FedEx Express. The following are descriptions of the fees applicable to value added services.

FedEx® Delivery Signature Options	The following delivery signature options ⁽⁴⁾ may be chosen at the time of booking your shipment: 1. No Signature Required: FedEx will attempt to obtain a signature at the delivery address. If no one is available to sign, FedEx will deliver the package in a safe place without obtaining signature. 2. Indirect Signature Required: FedEx will obtain a signature from someone at the delivery address, from a neighbour or from a building manager. If no one is available to sign, FedEx will attempt to redeliver the package. 3. Direct Signature Required: FedEx will obtain a signature from someone at the delivery address only. If no one is available to sign, FedEx will attempt to redeliver the package. 4. Adult Signature Required: FedEx will obtain a signature from any person of legal age at the delivery address, subject to sighting of a valid ID. If no one eligible to sign is available, FedEx will attempt to redeliver the package. Your transportation costs may be affected by additional charges. The following are descriptions of the surcharges.

Additional Handling Surcharge	Effective January 6, 2025, FedEx will assess an Additional Handling Surcharge per eligible package for international multi-piece shipments, instead of per shipment. Package Services An Additional Handling Surcharge applies to any package that meets any of the following criteria: Dimension • measures greater than 121 centimeters along its longest side; • measures greater than 76 centimeters along its second-longest side; or, • measures greater than 266 centimeters in length and girth (L+2W+2H). * Subject to a 40-lb. minimum billable weight. Weight • has an actual weight greater than 31kg. Packaging • is not fully encased in an outer shipping container; • is encased in an outer shipping container not made of corrugated fibreboard (cardboard) materials, including but not limited to metal, wood, canvas, leather, hard plastic, soft plastic, or expanded polystyrene foam (e.g. Styrofoam); • is encased in an outer shipping container covered in shrink wrap or stretch wrap; • is round or cylindrical, including (without limitation) mailing tubes, cans, buckets, barrels, tires, drums, or pails; • is bound with metal, plastic, or cloth banding, or has wheels, casters, handles, or straps (e.g., a bicycle) (including packages where the outer surface area is loosely wrapped, or where the contents protrude outside the surface area); • could become entangled in, or cause damage to other packages or the FedEx sortation system. We reserve the right to assess additional handling charges for packages that require special handling or that require FedEx to apply additional packaging during transit. If a package is eligible for 2 or all 3 Additional Handling Surcharges, only 1 with greater charge will apply. Package shape and dimensions may change during transit, which can affect the package's surcharge eligibility. If the dimensions change during transit, FedEx may make appropriate adjustments to the shipment charges at any time. Additional Handling Surcharge – Non-stackable	freight handling unit that requires special handling during transit. Effective January 6, 2025, FedEx will assess an Additional Handling Surcharge per eligible package for international multi-piece shipments, instead of per shipment. A surcharge applies to any freight handling unit that is non-stackable, which means the piece, skid, or pallet cannot be stacked vertically in a safe and secure manner. Examples include, but are not limited to, non-stackable freight handling units that: do not have a flat and stable top or base; may be damaged if another piece is loaded on them; or, have flat and stable loading surfaces but are too narrow to safely and securely support other freight handling units (e.g. 1-2 barrels or drums). Address Correction	If a recipient's address on an Air Bill, Air Waybill or shipping label is incomplete or incorrect, we may attempt to find the correct address and complete delivery and we will assess a surcharge. If we are unable to complete delivery, we are not liable for failing to meet our delivery commitment. For FedEx International Broker Select, the address correction surcharge will apply if the broker's address is incomplete or incorrect on the Air Waybill or other shipping documentation. If we cannot determine the correct address or cannot reach the broker, we may attempt to contact the sender for address clarification or instructions to return the shipment. Advancement Fee	Duties, taxes and other charges might be due when importing a shipment. FedEx may advance payment of these fees as assessed by customs on behalf of the payer. Additional Handling Surcharge – Oversize Charge	Effective January 6, 2025, FedEx will assess an Additional Handling Surcharge per eligible package for international multi-piece shipments, instead of per shipment. An oversize charge applies to a package that exceed 243 centimeters in length* or 330 centimeters in length* and girth (L+2W+2H). Package shape and dimensions may change during transit, which can affect the package's surcharge eligibility. If the dimensions change during transit, FedEx may make appropriate adjustments to the shipment charges at any time. * FedEx international shipments will be subject to a 40-lb. minimum billable weight when the shipment also meets the criteria of the Additional Handling Surcharge Dimension. Postal Fee	For non-document shipments up to and including 30kg, and for all documents, a postal fee surcharge of 10% applies.	
Reimbursement on Delivery (ROD) Fee	A fee is charged to compensate FedEx for operating a direct payment process allowing release of shipments and payment of customs charges for customers who do not have a FedEx account number.	None
Saturday Delivery Charges	A surcharge might apply to a delivery performed on a Saturday. Service availability may vary according to place of collection and destination. When Saturday is a normal business day at the destination country/territory, Saturday Delivery does not have to be marked on the Air Waybill, and the surcharge does not apply.
