You can customise your FedEx core services shipments to your needs (or the needs of your recipients) with value added services from FedEx Express. The following are descriptions of the fees applicable to value added services.

Third Party Consignee	FedEx Third Party Consignee International Priority service (TPC) is our value-added service for customers who do not want to reveal the actual commercial value of the shipment and the shipper details to their consignees. No Signature Required: FedEx will attempt to obtain a signature at the delivery address. If no one is available to sign, FedEx will deliver the package in a safe place without obtaining signature. 2. Indirect Signature Required: FedEx will obtain a signature from someone at the delivery address, from a neighbour or from a building manager. If no one is available to sign, FedEx will attempt to redeliver the package. 3. Direct Signature Required: FedEx will obtain a signature from someone at the delivery address only. If no one is available to sign, FedEx will attempt to redeliver the package. 4. Adult Signature Required: FedEx will obtain a signature from any person of legal age at the delivery address, subject to sighting of a valid ID. Package shape and dimensions may change during transit, which can affect the package's surcharge eligibility. If the dimensions change during transit, FedEx may make appropriate adjustments to the shipment charges at any time.</p> <p>Freight Services A surcharge applies to a shipment containing any freight handling unit that measures greater than 157 centimetres along its longest side. Additional Handling Surcharge – Non-stackable⁽⁶⁾	A surcharge applies to any FedEx International Priority Freight and FedEx International Economy Freight shipment containing at least one piece, skid or pallet that is non-stackable. Non-stackable means that a piece, skid or pallet cannot be stacked vertically in a safe and secure manner. This surcharge applies once per shipment, even if multiple pieces identified as non-stackable are bundled in a shipment.	£114/shipment
Address Correction	<p>If a recipient's address on an Air Bill, Air Waybill or shipping label is incomplete or incorrect, we may attempt to find the correct address and complete delivery and we will assess a surcharge. If we are unable to complete delivery, we are not liable for failing to meet our delivery commitment.</p> <p>For FedEx International Broker Select, the address correction surcharge will apply if the broker's address is incomplete or incorrect on the Air Waybill or other shipping documentation. If we cannot determine the correct address or cannot reach the broker, we may attempt to contact the sender for address clarification or instructions to return the shipment.
