



Value Added Services and Surcharges (VASS)

FedEx Express offers a range of options for your shipments which may incur additional fees or surcharges. Below you can find more information on these extra services and other useful shipping information.

Value Added Services^{(1) (2)}

You can customise your FedEx services to your needs (or the needs of your recipients) with value added services from FedEx Express. The following are descriptions of the fees applicable to value added services.

<p>Dangerous Goods Only available on Express Services.</p> <p>FedEx Express Dangerous Goods services allow the shipping of regulated dangerous substances and materials including door-to-door delivery and customs clearance. FedEx® Delivery Signature Options The following delivery signature options ⁽²⁾ may be chosen at the time of booking your shipment: 1. No Signature Required: FedEx will attempt to obtain a signature at the delivery address. If no one is available to sign, FedEx will deliver the package in a safe place without obtaining signature. 2. Indirect Signature Required: FedEx will obtain a signature from someone at the delivery address, from a neighbour or from a building manager. If no one is available to sign, FedEx will attempt to redeliver the package. 3. Direct Signature Required: FedEx will obtain a signature from someone at the delivery address only. If no one is available to sign, FedEx will attempt to redeliver the package. 4. Adult Signature Required: FedEx will obtain a signature from any person of legal age at the delivery address, subject to sighting of a valid ID. If no one eligible to sign is available, FedEx will attempt to redeliver the package. Legal age will vary depending on the destination country/territory and is governed by local legal age of an adult, not the legal age to purchase specific products (e.g. alcohol).	1. None 2. None. Your transportation costs may be affected by additional charges. The following are descriptions of the surcharges.

Additional Handling Surcharge Package Services A surcharge applies per package or piece that: Dimension <ul style="list-style-type: none"> measures greater than 121 centimetres along its longest side; measures greater than 76 centimetres along its second-longest side; or, measures greater than 266 centimetres in length and girth - the length and girth is length plus (two times the height) plus (two times the width). Packaging <ul style="list-style-type: none"> is not fully encased in an outer shipping container or packaging; is encased in an outer shipping container or packaging not made of corrugated fibreboard (cardboard) materials, including but not limited to metal, wood, canvas, leather, hard plastic, soft plastic, or expanded polystyrene foam (e.g. Styrofoam); is encased in an outer shipping container or packaging covered in shrink wrap or stretch wrap; is round or cylindrical, including (without limitation) mailing tubes, cans, buckets, barrels, tires, drums, or pails; is bound with metal, plastic, or cloth banding, or has wheels (e.g. a bicycle), casters, handles, or straps, including packages where the outer surface area is loosely wrapped, or where the contents protrude outside the surface area; could become entangled in, or cause damage to other packages or the FedEx sortation system. Weight <ul style="list-style-type: none"> has an actual weight greater than 31kg. Package shape and dimensions may change during transit, which can affect the package's dimensional weight and surcharge eligibility. If the package shape and dimensions change during transit, FedEx may make appropriate adjustments to the charges at any time. This surcharge applies per piece even if multiple pieces are bundled in a shipment. If a non-standard package is eligible for two or all three Additional Handling Surcharges (Dimension, Weight, or Packaging), only the one with highest charge will apply. Additional Handling Surcharge – Non-stackable⁽⁹⁾ A surcharge applies to any freight handling unit of a freight shipment that is non-stackable. Non-stackable means that the freight handling unit cannot be stacked vertically in a safe and secure manner. Examples include, but are not limited to, non-stackable freight handling units that: 1) do not have a flat and stable top or base, 2) may be damaged if another piece is loaded on them, or 3) have flat and stable loading surfaces but are too narrow to safely and securely support other freight handling units (e.g. 1-2 barrels or drums). A surcharge also applies to any freight handling unit identified by the shipper as non-stackable. This surcharge applies on a per-freight-handling-unit basis even if multiple pieces of freight are bundled in a shipment.
