

## Value Added Services and Surcharges (VASS)



FedEx offers a range of options for your shipments which may incur additional fees or surcharges. Below you can find more information on these extra services and other useful shipping information.

### Value Added Services<sup>(1) (2)</sup>

You can customise your FedEx services to your needs (or the needs of your recipients) with our value added services. The following are descriptions of the fees applicable to value added services.

<p><b>Dangerous Goods</b></p> <p>FedEx Dangerous Goods services allow the shipping of regulated dangerous substances and materials including door-to-door delivery and customs clearance. Applicable fee depends on the Dangerous Goods type and service used:</p> <p><b>For Dangerous Goods transported by air (IATA)</b>  <i>Dangerous Goods transported by Air service included in this ratecard is expected to be available for the market in 2025.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Accessible Dangerous Goods (ADG)</b> The content of package must be accessible during transit for safety reasons.</li> <li>• <b>Inaccessible Dangerous Goods (IDG)</b> The content of package does not have to be accessed during transit and can be mixed with other freight.</li> </ul> <p><b>For Dangerous Goods transported by road (ADR)<sup>(4)</sup></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Fully Regulated Dangerous Goods (FDG)<sup>(5)</sup></b> Must be prepared, packed, marked, labelled and documented in full compliance with ADR regulations.</li> <li>• <b>Limited Quantities Dangerous Goods (LDG)<sup>(5)</sup></b> Package contains small quantities of dangerous goods packed, marked and labelled in compliance with ADR regulations.</li> <li>• <b>Standalone Lithium Batteries (EBB)<sup>(5)</sup></b> Two commodities are covered:  1. Standalone Lithium Ion Batteries (UN 3480 – ADR SP 188).</li> </ul> <p><b>For Dangerous Goods transported by air (IATA) or by road (ADR)<sup>(4)</sup></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Dangerous Goods in Excepted Quantities (REQ)<sup>(5)</sup></b> Package contains very small quantities of dangerous goods packed, marked and labelled in compliance with IATA or ADR regulations.</li> <li>• <b>Dry Ice (DI)</b> When transported by air (IATA), Dry Ice is a hazardous commodity that requires special handling, subject to simplified regulations. This means it can only be offered in locations where fully regulated Dangerous Goods services are offered.  When transported by road (ADR)<sup>(4)</sup>, Dry Ice is not considered as Dangerous Goods and therefore is not subject to these DG limitations in countries.</li> <li>• <b>Lithium Batteries Section II (ELB)</b> Four commodities are covered:  1. Lithium Ion Batteries packed with equipment (UN 3481 – Packing Instruction 966).  2. Lithium Ion Batteries contained in equipment (UN 3481 – Packing Instruction 967).  3. Lithium Metal Batteries packed with equipment (UN 3091 – Packing Instruction 969).  4. <p><b>Diplomatic Bag (Diplomatic Mail)<sup>(9)</sup></b></p> <p>We accept diplomatic shipments between embassies and consulates of the same country/territory for delivery by International Priority service. As per the Vienna Convention of 1961, Diplomatic Bags receive diplomatic immunity from inspection or delay.</p>	None
<p><b>FedEx® Electronic Trade Documents</b></p> <p>With FedEx Electronic Trade Documents (ETD) you can streamline your international shipments by uploading your customs documentation electronically. ETD reduces the amount of paper you print for each shipment, allows for faster pick-up and helps to pre-clear your shipments, reducing the risk of your shipment being delayed in customs. <p><b>FedEx Customs Brokerage Services</b></p> <p>FedEx offers a seamless standard customs clearance process to enable on-time delivery of your goods. <p><b>FedEx® Delivery Signature Options</b></p> <p>The following delivery signature options<sup>(10)</sup> may be chosen at the time of booking your shipment:</p> <p><b>1. No Signature Required:</b> FedEx will attempt to obtain a signature at the delivery address. If no one is available to sign, FedEx will deliver the package in a safe place without obtaining signature.</p> <p><b>2. Indirect Signature Required:</b> FedEx will obtain a signature from someone at the delivery address or from somebody nearby, such as a neighbour or building manager. The recipient has the option to utilise any FedEx-approved means to authorise the shipment to be released without anyone present.</p> <p><b>3. Direct Signature Required:</b> FedEx will obtain a signature from someone at the delivery address only. If no one is available to sign, FedEx will attempt to redeliver the package.</p> <p><b>4. Adult Signature Required:</b> FedEx will obtain a signature from any person of legal age at the delivery address, subject to sighting of a valid ID. If no one eligible to sign is available, FedEx will attempt to redeliver the package. Legal age will vary depending on the destination country/territory and is governed by local legal age of an adult, not the legal age to purchase specific products (e.g. alcohol).</p>	<p><b>1.</b> None</p> <p><b>2.</b> None. ## Surcharges<sup>(1) (2)</sup>

Your transportation costs may be affected by additional charges. The following are descriptions of the surcharges.

<p><b>Additional Handling Surcharge</b></p> <p><b>Package Services</b></p> <p>A surcharge applies per package or piece that:</p> <p><b>Dimension</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>measures greater than 121 centimetres along its longest side;</li> <li>measures greater than 76 centimetres along its second-longest side; or,</li> <li>measures greater than 266 centimetres in length and girth - the length and girth is length plus (two times the height) plus (two times the width).</li> </ul> <p><b>Packaging</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>is not fully encased in an outer shipping container or packaging;</li> <li>is encased in an outer shipping container or packaging not made of corrugated fibreboard (cardboard) materials, including but not limited to metal, wood, canvas, leather, hard plastic, soft plastic, or expanded polystyrene foam (e.g. Styrofoam);</li> <li>is encased in an outer shipping container or packaging covered in shrink wrap or stretch wrap;</li> <li>is round or cylindrical, including (without limitation) mailing tubes, cans, buckets, barrels, tires, drums, or pails;</li> <li>is bound with metal, plastic, or cloth banding, or has wheels (e.g. a bicycle), casters, handles, or straps, including packages where the outer surface area is loosely wrapped, or where the contents protrude outside the surface area;</li> <li>could become entangled in, or cause damage to other packages or the FedEx sortation system.</li> </ul> <p><b>Weight</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>has an actual weight greater than 31kg.</li> </ul> <p>Package shape and dimensions may change during transit, which can affect the package's dimensional weight and surcharge eligibility. If the package shape and dimensions change during transit, FedEx may make appropriate adjustments to the charges at any time. This surcharge applies per piece even if multiple pieces are bundled in a shipment. If a non-standard package is eligible for two or all three Additional Handling Surcharges (Dimension, Weight, or Packaging), only the one with highest charge will apply.</p> <p>FedEx reserves the right to assess Additional Handling charges for packages that require special handling or that require FedEx to apply additional packaging during transit.</p> <p><b>Freight Services</b></p> <p>A surcharge applies to any freight handling unit that measures greater than 157 centimetres<sup>(11)</sup> along its longest side. This surcharge applies on a per-freight-handling-unit basis even if multiple pieces of freight are bundled in a shipment. We reserve the right to assess additional handling charges for freight and any freight handling unit that requires special handling during transit.</p>	<p>USD 39/package</p> <p>USD 28/package</p> <p>USD 39.60/package</p> <p>USD 60/freight handling unit</p>
<p><b>Additional Handling Surcharge – Non-stackable<sup>(12)</sup></b></p> <p>A surcharge applies to any freight handling unit of a freight shipment that is non-stackable. Non-stackable means that the freight handling unit cannot be stacked vertically in a safe and secure manner. Examples include, but are not limited to, non-stackable freight handling units that: 1) do not have a flat and stable top or base, 2) may be damaged if another piece is loaded on them, or 3) have flat and stable loading surfaces but are too narrow to safely and securely support other freight handling units (e.g. 1-2 barrels or drums). A surcharge also applies to any freight handling unit identified by the shipper as non-stackable. <b>Address Correction</b> <p>If a recipient's address on an Air Bill, Air Waybill or shipping label is incomplete or incorrect, we may attempt to find the correct address and complete delivery and we will assess a surcharge. If we are unable to complete delivery, we are not liable for failing to meet our delivery commitment.</p> <p>For FedEx International Broker Select, the address correction surcharge will apply if the broker's address is incomplete or incorrect on the Air Waybill or other shipping documentation. If we cannot determine the correct address or cannot reach the broker, we may attempt to contact the sender for address clarification or instructions to return the shipment. If we are unable to complete delivery under these circumstances, we will not be liable for failing to meet our delivery commitment.</p>	USD 10/shipment
<b>Declared Value</b> <p>The sender may elect to pay an additional charge to specify a Declared Value for Carriage on the Air Waybill, above the standard limits of liability. FedEx does not provide a cargo all-risks insurance.</p> <p>The Declared Value for Carriage is limited to a maximum amount and may vary by location. <b>Fuel Surcharge</b> <b>International Fuel Surcharge</b> <p>FedEx has adopted a Dynamic Fuel Surcharge according to the variation in the price of kerosene-type jet fuel for all international services except FedEx Regional Economy<sup>(8)</sup> and FedEx Regional Economy Freight<sup>(8)</sup>. FedEx reserves the right to apply a fuel surcharge.</p> <b>Regional Fuel Surcharge</b> <p>For FedEx Regional Economy<sup>(8)</sup> and FedEx Regional Economy Freight<sup>(8)</sup> services, FedEx has adopted a Dynamic Fuel Surcharge which is based on the automotive gas oil prices from the EU country/territory zone. <b>Oversize Charge</b> An oversize charge applies to a package or piece that exceeds 243 centimetres in length or 330 centimetres in length and girth - the length and girth is length plus (two times the height) plus (two times the width). Package shape and dimensions may change during transit, which can affect the package's surcharge eligibility. If the dimensions change during transit, FedEx may make appropriate adjustments to the charges at any time.	USD 60/package
<b>Third Party Billing</b> Third Party Billing Surcharge will apply to shipments that are billed to a third party. The surcharge will be charged to the third-party payer <sup>(13)</sup> . The surcharge applies when the shipper account number and the third party billing account number are not part of the same company, as determined by FedEx.	2.5% of total shipment charges. Total shipment charges includes transportation charges, surcharges and additional fees; but does not include duties, taxes and clearance service fees.
