



Demand surcharge adjustment on shipments to/from Israel,
effective June 30, 2025

FedEx service to/from Israel has been reinstated, effective June 27, 2025. FedEx continues to make adjustments within our network to best deliver to our customers.

Effective June 30, 2025, a Demand Surcharge will apply to FedEx shipments to and from Israel for South Africa, due to increased operational costs.

The Demand Surcharge will be applicable for **South Africa** as below.

Services for DS re-introduction include:

1. Parcel: FedEx International First, FedEx International Priority Express, FedEx International Priority, FedEx International Economy & 10/25kg Box
Freight: FedEx International Priority Freight, FedEx International Economy Freight
2. Service availability differs across different markets
