



Demand Surcharge update effective April 13, 2026

Effective April 13, 2026, the Demand Surcharge (DS) on shipments from Israel will be reduced from \$3.30/kg to \$1.10/kg due to increased capacity for FedEx international parcel and freight shipments to the Middle East[^], India, North Africa, and Sub-Saharan Africa (SSA²), while all other lanes will continue as per the existing structure until further notice.

1. **Services for Demand Surcharge include:**

Parcel: FedEx International First, FedEx International Priority Express, FedEx International Priority, FedEx International Economy, 10/25kg Box, FedEx International Priority Direct Distribution (IPD) and FedEx International Connect Plus (FICP)

Freight: FedEx International Priority Freight, FedEx International Economy Freight

2. **SSA:** Kenya, Malawi, Namibia, Nigeria, South Africa, Eswatini, Zambia, Mozambique & Botswana

3. Service availability differs across different markets
