



Demand Surcharge update effective April 24, 2026

Effective April 24, 2026, the Demand Surcharge (DS) on shipments to Israel will be revised on FedEx international parcel and freight shipments as below.

- Export DS to Israel will be reduced from USD 3.30/kg to USD 1.10/kg

Demand surcharge on other lanes remain unchanged until further notice.

1. **Services for Demand Surcharge include:**

Parcel: FedEx International First, FedEx International Priority Express, FedEx International Priority, FedEx International Economy, 10/25kg Box, FedEx International Priority Direct Distribution (IPD) and FedEx International Connect Plus (FICP)

Freight: FedEx International Priority Freight, FedEx International Economy Freight

2. Service availability differs across different markets
3. For third-party shipments Demand Surcharge will be assessed based on the origin country / territory unless the customer is registered for global third-party service

Note: Surcharge changes may impact other origin/destination countries falling in the same zone.
