Exterior

1 High-quality **poster prints** in windows or **mounted posters** on easels pack a visual punch and serve as one of your first lines of defense.

- Display hours of operation
- Give directions to locations within the building
- Welcome customers and employees
- Indicate capacity limits

2 **Hanging banners** are a big, bold way to make a first impression and ensure your message is visible near and far.

- Let customers know you're open
- Share promotions

3 **Surface graphics** are an effective and easy way to convey your message on smooth or uneven surfaces.

- Display hours of operation
- Provide occupancy guidelines
- Post safety guidelines
- Direct traffic flow
- Instruct where to stand and wait
- Mark parking spaces

4 **Signs** are a portable way to communicate your message wherever you need it the most.

- Direct traffic flow
- Indicate curbside pickup
- Provide parking instructions

Reception area and lobby

1 Signs help prevent confusion and maintain order in your reception area, which makes doing business smooth and efficient.

- Direct or control traffic
- Provide spatial guidelines
- Draw attention to specific locations like hand sanitizer or temperature-check stations
- Eliminate the need for employees to repeat the same information to every customer served
- Declare an area off limits
- Show where the line forms

2 Framed and unframed posters are clever visual tools that catch the attention of customers and employees as they enter your workplace and waiting area.

- Welcome back customers or employees
- Provide motivation
- Introduce recently enacted changes in protocol or safety guidelines
- Place near elevators where they'll be seen while waiting, and even encourage taking the stairs
- Educate team members

3 Retractable banners look professional and are versatile, mobile and easy to set up.

- Greet customers
- State CDC guidelines
- Make customers aware of policies

- Instruct where to stand and wait
- Ensure a safe distance is maintained
- Direct traffic flow

- Maintain compliance

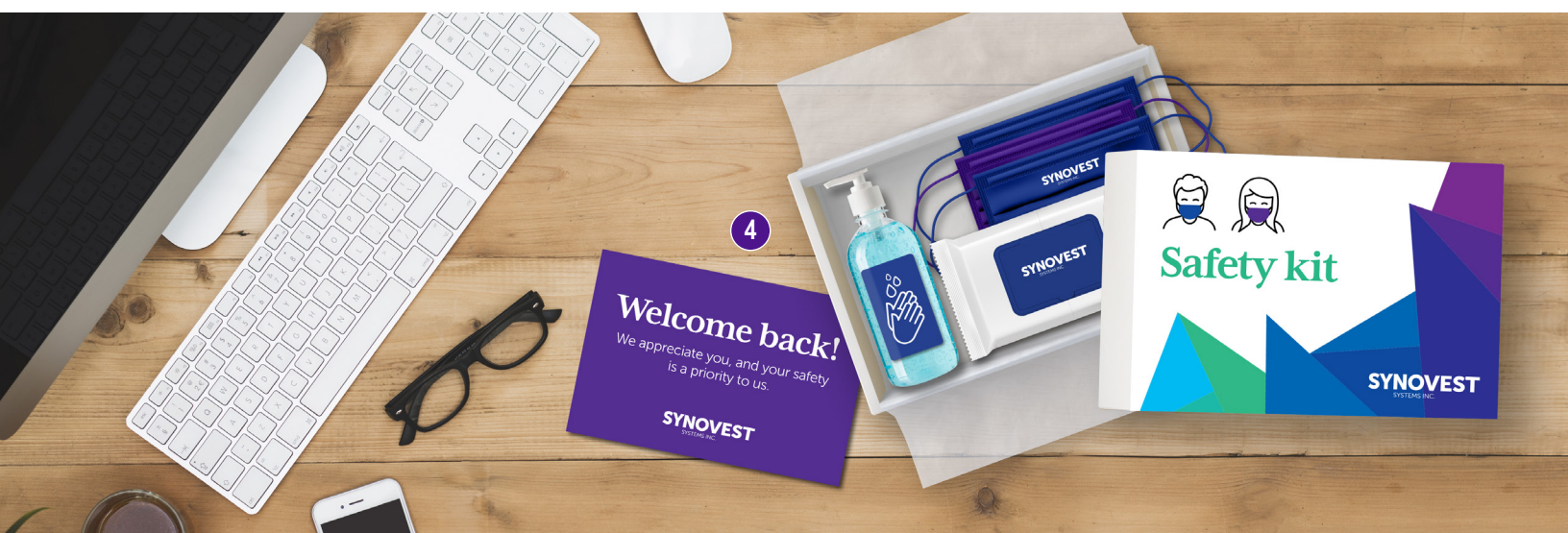
3 Surface graphics are effective for informing, providing structure and helping enforce social distancing.

2 **Signs** are an efficient way to maximize small spaces.

- Limit the number of people who can sit at a table
- Keep track of custodial sanitation schedules
- Provide best practices for personal sanitation and sterilization

- Promote spatial restrictions

3 **Procedure cards** provide information at a glance.

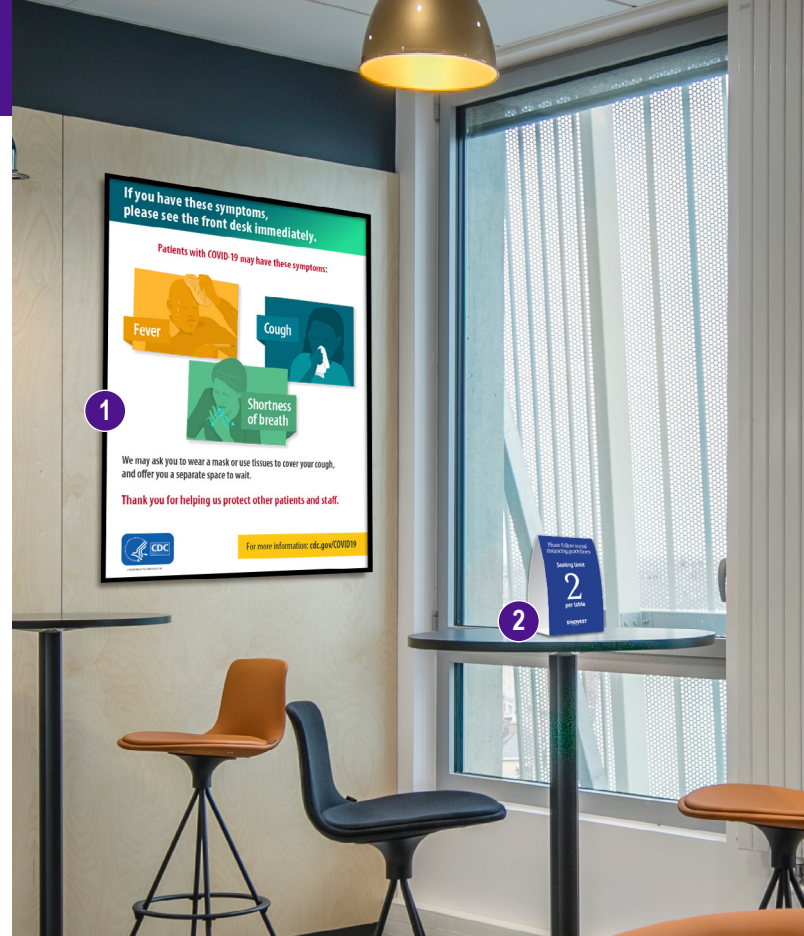
- Keep important guidelines within sight and at fingertips
