Regulatory Alert: New Zealand Customs Fees Changes from 1 July 2025

July 1, 2025

Effective 1 July 2025, the New Zealand Government will change customs goods fees. The fee changes reflect the costs of goods management activities and introduce structural adjustments to enhance fairness for fee payers and taxpayers.

Q 1 - Why are the fees being increased?

A1 - As stated by the New Zealand Customs Service, changes to fees reflect the costs of goods management activities and make structural changes to improve fairness to fee payers and to taxpayers. Overall, the changes will support the ongoing financial sustainability of New Zealand Customs and the Ministry for Primary Industries' (MPI) goods management system.
