



# FedEx Regulatory Alerts & Updates

## **Regulatory Alert Update: Update – Munitions of War (MOW) Articles Strictly Prohibited into or through Singapore**

December 24, 2019

FedEx does not accept any guns, ammunition, weaponry or their parts (even if these parts are empty). This would include items such as:

- Rifles, pistols, and any other form of gun including its ammunition, explosives, and cartridges
- Components and parts of weapons such as weapon barrels, bolts/magazines, and firing pins required for the normal functioning of the weapon
- Military/armored vehicles or aircraft with installed/mounted weapons
- Air pistols or rifles designed to shoot metallic projectiles, as well as functional antique firearms

Please make sure that you accurately declare in the commodity description all items being sent via FedEx, including “Munitions of War” (MOW). MOW, in this update, refers to any weapon and ammunition designed for use in warfare, or any weapon or ammunition designed for use against any person, including any part designed for such weapons and ammunition.

Separately, and specifically in relation to Singapore, please do not send any MOW to Singapore. No MOW shipment is allowed to transit via Singapore or be shipped to Singapore. Failure to comply with this advice may result in your shipment being delayed, confiscated, or destroyed by law enforcement in Singapore.

If you are unsure as to whether certain goods might constitute a prohibited item under MOW, before accepting the shipment, you may reach out to FedEx Customer Service.
