

# 2018 Holiday Schedule

Stay ahead this holiday season. Knowing our holiday schedule can help you offer a great customer experience by avoiding shipping delays.

## Thanksgiving

### Wednesday, November 21, 2018

- FedEx Office will close by 6 p.m.
- FedEx Money-Back Guarantee for FedEx Express® shipments suspended for shipments delivered within 90 minutes of the published delivery commitment time for the selected service and destination<sup>1</sup>

### Thursday, November 22, 2018

- FedEx Express, FedEx Ground, FedEx Home Delivery®, FedEx SmartPost®, FedEx Freight, FedEx Office, and FedEx Trade Networks unavailable<sup>2,3</sup>
- Per Money-Back Guarantee section of the FedEx Service Guide, shipments scheduled for delivery on a holiday will be delivered the next business day<sup>1</sup>

### Friday, November 23, 2018

- Early on-call pickups and drop box closings in some areas for FedEx Express
- FedEx Freight unavailable

### Saturday, November 24, 2018

- Early on-call pickups in some areas for FedEx Express
- FedEx Ground and FedEx Freight unavailable

### Monday, November 26, 2018

- The money-back guarantee for FedEx Ground and FedEx Home Delivery will be suspended for packages picked up between Monday, November 26 and Monday, December 24, 2018<sup>1</sup>

## Christmas

### Monday, December 17, 2018

- FedEx Freight no-fee, money-back guarantee suspended for shipments with required delivery dates of Monday, December 17, 2018, through Wednesday, January 2, 2019<sup>1</sup>

### Tuesday, December 18, 2018

- FedEx Express shipments delivered by the end of the day on published delivery commitment dates between December 18 and 24 are not eligible for the FedEx Money-Back Guarantee

### Saturday, December 22, 2018

- Saturday pickups are available for FedEx First Overnight®, FedEx Priority Overnight®, and FedEx Standard Overnight® shipments in our A1, A2, AA, A4, A5, and AM primary service areas for a special handling fee. Saturday pickups are also available in select ZIP codes in A6 and PM service areas. Saturday dropoffs are available at various convenient locations. - FedEx SmartPost will make deliveries, but not pickups
- FedEx Ground and FedEx Freight unavailable

### Sunday, December 23, 2018

- FedEx Office will close by 6 p.m.
- FedEx Express, FedEx Ground, FedEx Home Delivery, FedEx SmartPost, and FedEx Freight unavailable

### Monday, December 24, 2018

- FedEx Express stations, on-call pickups, and drop boxes will be closed in some areas
- FedEx Office will close by 6 p.m.
- FedEx Home Delivery and FedEx Freight unavailable

### Tuesday, December 25, 2018

- FedEx Express, FedEx Ground, FedEx Home Delivery, FedEx SmartPost, FedEx Freight, FedEx Office, and FedEx Trade Networks unavailable<sup>2,3</sup>

## New Year's

### Saturday, December 29, 2018

- FedEx Ground, FedEx SmartPost, and FedEx Freight unavailable

### Sunday, December 30, 2018

- FedEx Express, FedEx Ground, FedEx Home Delivery, FedEx SmartPost, and FedEx Freight unavailable

### Monday, December 31, 2018

- FedEx Express stations, on-call pickups, and drop boxes will close early in some areas
- FedEx Office will close by 6 p.m.
- FedEx Home Delivery unavailable
- FedEx Freight will be open with only prearranged pickup and delivery shipments being made. FedEx Freight® shipments picked up on December 31, 2018, will resume on January 2, 2019. For example, a one-day shipment picked up on December 31, 2018, will resume on January 2, 2019, and deliver on January 3, 2019.

### Tuesday, January 1, 2019

- FedEx Express, FedEx Ground, FedEx Home Delivery, FedEx SmartPost, FedEx Freight, FedEx Office, and FedEx Trade Networks unavailable<sup>2,3</sup>
