

FedEx Office Storage - Prohibited Items List

Depositors must NOT submit any of the following items (“Prohibited Items”) for storage:

1. Any individual item over 150 pounds
2. Items that require controlled temperature storage
3. Food or perishable items
4. Items that are wet, leaking, emit an odor of any kind, or would otherwise constitute a hazard to other stored items
5. Liquids, regardless of size/amount
6. Sofa beds, oversized furniture
7. Money, cash, coins, currency, paper money and negotiable instruments equivalent to cash, such as endorsed stocks, bonds and cash letters; lottery tickets
8. Government or school issued identification (passport, driver’s license, student ID)
9. All plants, animals, or insects
10. Flammable materials, explosives, fireworks, or other inherently dangerous material; or items resembling a bomb, hand grenade or other explosive or incendiary device
11. Firearms (whether assembled or disassembled) or ammunition
12. Lithium ion batteries
13. Waste material (including any hazardous or medical waste)
14. Hazardous materials, including but not limited to any hazardous or toxic chemical, gas, liquid, substance, material or waste that is or becomes regulated under any applicable local, state or federal law or regulation
15. Any personal property which would result in the violation of any law or regulation of any governmental authority, including, without limitation, all laws and regulations relating to hazardous materials, waste disposal, and other environmental matters.
16. Tobacco and tobacco products (including but not limited to cigarettes, cigars, loose tobacco, smokeless tobacco, hookah or shisha), e-cigarettes, vaping products and supplies
17. Marijuana, as defined by U.S. federal law, 21 U.S.C. 802(16), including marijuana intended for recreational or medicinal use; any product that contains any amount of tetrahydrocannabinols (“THC”); and synthetic cannabinoids
18. Computers, tablets, computer software or programs, media or computer data contained on hard disks or drives
19. Items of extraordinary value (including, but not limited to, jewelry, antiques, furs, items the value of which is derived by rarity or difficulty to replace)
20. Motorized vehicles, motorcycles, engines
