National Small Business Leaders Survey


Morning Consult, on behalf of FedEx, conducted a national survey of 1,592 small business executives from March 09-21, 2017. The survey used a stratified design based on company size and industry sector. Morning Consult interviewed small business executives with titles such as owner, founder, chief executive, president, vice president, director, and other C-suite titles. Results from the full survey have a margin of error of +/- 2 percentage points.

Eight in 10 small business leaders (84%) say expanding trade and opportunities between the U.S. and foreign customers is a good thing


In general, do you think expanding trade and business opportunities between the United States and customers in other countries is a good or bad thing?





Eight in 10 small business leaders (80%) agree that increasing trade will improve the economy overall


Please indicate if you agree or disagree with the following statements...Increasing trade between the US and other countries will improve the economy overall.





Three in four small business leaders (76%) agree that increasing trade will create opportunities and jobs


