

FedEx® DG Ready. How it works.

Use fully integrated workflow if you have:

- Shipping label integration with FedEx Web Services or FedEx Ship Manager® Server versions 2016 or later.

Use partial or non-integrated workflow if you have:

- Shipping label integration with pre-2016 versions of FedEx Web Services or FedEx Ship Manager Server.
- No shipping label integration with FedEx Web Services or FedEx Ship Manager Server.

Fully Integrated Workflow

STEP 1: DG DECLARATION OR HAZMAT SHIPPING PAPER PRE-VALIDATION

To be notified of documentation errors and correct them before you ship, use a FedEx DG Ready software solution.



STEP 2: SHIPPING LABEL GENERATION

To reduce manual errors and save time, integrate your FedEx DG Ready solution with the new shipping label generation options now available in FedEx Web Services and FedEx Ship Manager Server.



After successful pre-validation, FedEx Web Services or FedEx Ship Manager Server receives pre-assigned tracking numbers from the FedEx DG Ready software solution.

STEP 3: OFFER PRE-VALIDATED SHIPMENT TO FEDEX

After completing required marking, labeling, and packaging requirements, your pre-validated DG or hazmat shipment is ready to ship.

- Shipping label integration with FedEx Web Services or FedEx Ship Manager® Server versions 2016 or later.

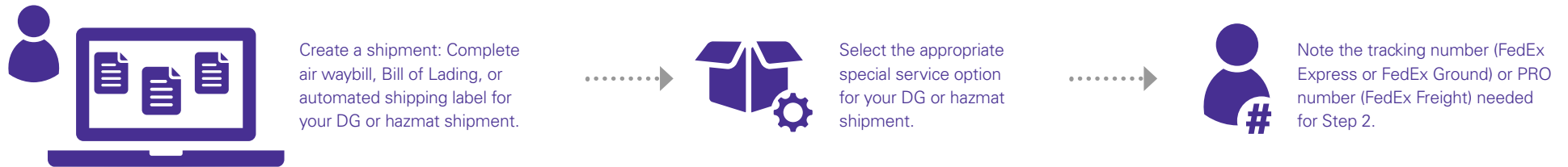
Use partial or non-integrated workflow if you have:

- Shipping label integration with pre-2016 versions of FedEx Web Services or FedEx Ship Manager Server.
- No shipping label integration with FedEx Web Services or FedEx Ship Manager Server.

Partial or Non-Integrated Workflow

STEP 1: INITIATE SHIPPING LABEL*

NOTE: Generating shipping labels by any method not capable of full FedEx DG Ready integration* will not achieve the error reduction or time savings achievable with the fully integrated workflow.



STEP 2: DG DECLARATION OR HAZMAT SHIPPING PAPER PRE-VALIDATION

To be notified of documentation errors and correct them before you ship, use a FedEx DG Ready software solution.



STEP 3: OFFER PRE-VALIDATED SHIPMENT TO FEDEX

After completing required marking, labeling, and packaging requirements, your pre-validated DG or hazmat shipment is ready to ship.



*Versions 2016 and later of FedEx Web Services and FedEx Ship Manager® Server can be fully integrated with FedEx DG Ready for shipping label generation. Other shipping label solutions that are not integrated with FedEx DG Ready include, but are not limited to, FedEx® International Air Waybill, FedEx Freight Bill of Lading, FedEx Ground® Package Returns Program for hazardous materials shipments, FedEx Ship Manager®, FedEx Ship Manager® at fedex.com, and all pre-2016 versions of FedEx Web Services and FedEx Ship Manager Server.
