Delivery and Returns Surcharge¹ A per-package surcharge will be assessed on packages that are delivered or returned using FedEx Ground Economy services.	All services	\$1 per package

Dimensional Weight Dimensional weight is calculated by multiplying the length by width by height of each package in inches and dividing the total by 139. If the dimensional weight exceeds the actual weight, charges may be assessed based on the dimensional weight. If the chargeable weight of a FedEx Ground Economy package exceeds 70 lbs. for applicable FedEx Ground Economy services, separate published per-pound rates will apply. Package shape and dimensions may change during transit, which can affect the package's dimensional weight and surcharge eligibility. If the dimensions change during transit, FedEx may make appropriate adjustments to the shipment charges at any time. Dimensions of one-half inch or greater are rounded up to the next whole number; dimensions less than one-half inch are rounded down. The final calculation is rounded up to the next whole pound. Fuel Surcharge We reserve the right to assess fuel and other surcharges on shipments, without notice. We will determine the amount and duration of any such surcharges at our sole discretion. By tendering your shipments to FedEx, you agree to pay the surcharges, as determined by FedEx. FedEx Ground Economy will utilize the same fuel surcharge rate as FedEx Ground. Inbound Charge Optional charge associated with package pickup at customer's location. The charge is itemized separately from package-level charges. Non-Machinable Defined as: a) Any item with one dimension measuring more than 27 inches. b) Any item with any two dimensions each measuring more than 17 inches. c) Any item weighing over 35 lbs. d) Any item packaged in a cylindrical shipping tube.	All services	\$5.10 per package
Oversize Any item measuring more than 108 inches but not more than 130 inches in combined length and girth. The shipping charges for a FedEx Ground Economy oversize package will be based on the greatest of the package's actual rounded weight, dimensional weight and 71 lbs. Package Relabel A per-package surcharge will be assessed on packages that do not conform to specifications that require overlabel or hand key.	All services	\$0.80 per package

Third Party Billing Surcharge A surcharge will apply to shipments that are billed to a third party. The surcharge applies when an account unrelated to the shipper, as solely determined by FedEx, is billed as a third party for the shipment. It will be charged to the third-party payer. See the FedEx Service Guide for the definition of a Bill Third Party shipment.
