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Important message regarding changes for **Electronic Export Information (EEI),** formerly Shipper's Export Declaration (SED)

Changes in the Foreign Trade Regulations (FTR), effective July 2, 2008, affect your filing procedures for Electronic Export Information (EEI, formerly Shipper's Export Declaration or SED).

If a shipment requires EEI filing

- By Oct. 1, 2008, if an EEI is required for a shipment from the U.S., Puerto Rico or the U.S. Virgin Islands, the EEI must be electronically filed to the Automated Export System (AES) by the U.S. Principal Party in Interest (USPPI), which is generally the exporter, or their designated agent. Note that an EEI filing may be required for shipments between the U.S. and Puerto Rico and from the U.S. and Puerto Rico to the U.S. Virgin Islands. For details on EEI filing requirements, go to FedEx® Global Trade Manager on fedex.com or go to www.aesdirect.gov.
- The FTR requires an EEI to be transmitted 2 hours prior to export for most commodities shipped by air.
- For any commodity on the U.S. Munitions List (USML) or International Traffic in Arms Regulations (ITAR), an EEI must be transmitted 8 hours prior to export.
- The Internal Transaction Number (ITN), which is the AES proof of filing citation, is required on the electronic shipping labels prior to tendering the shipment to FedEx. FedEx recommends that you use the latest version of FedEx Ship Manager® Software to ensure that the ITN is on the air waybill.

If a shipment does not require EEI filing

- The FTR exemption must be displayed on the electronic shipping labels. For FedEx Express® shipments, the electronic shipping label serves as the international air waybill.
- The following exemptions are the most common when the shipment is not shipped on an export license or permit, is not subject to ITAR and is not rough diamonds:
 - NO EEI 30.36 Shipments to Canada.
 - NO EEI 30.37(a) Commodity value less than \$2,500.

Additional changes

- Foreign Trade Statistics Regulations (FTSR) is renamed Foreign Trade Regulations (FTR).
- Shipper's Export Declaration (SED) is eliminated and FTR requires filing of Electronic Export Information (EEI) to AES.
- The paper SED Commerce Form 7525-V can no longer be used.
- Civil penalties have increased from \$1,000 to \$10,000 per violation.
- New criminal penalties for EEI violations include up to \$10,000 in fines, and 5 years imprisonment, or both, per violation.
- The Option 4 filing program is renamed Postdeparture.

To facilitate compliance with government regulations and reduce the chance of shipping delays and/or penalties, FedEx provides solutions to make EEI filing as quick and easy as possible. Go to fedex.com/us/eei to find out how FedEx can help you file your EEI or determine if your shipment requires EEI filing.

Connectivity

Connectivity to the Web is a critical issue for the EEI regulations. It is strongly recommended that you investigate ways to avoid dial-up access to improve the speed and efficiency of the EEI features

FedEx EEI Filing Options

FedEx Ship Manager® Software v. 2358 includes features that provide Web-based self-filing or agent-filing EEI options. Both self-filing and agent-filing options have setup and registration requirements.

FedEx customers with export shipments that use FedEx Ship Manager Software need to be on v. 2358 (or higher) to avoid shipping delays or enforcement action from the FTR changes.

Follow three easy steps to make EEI filing fast and efficient:

- **1** Review the contents of this guide.
- 2 Ensure that the FedEx Ship Manager Software operator has a copy of this guide.
- **3** Review self-filing and agent-filing options and select your preference.
 - **Self-filers:** Start at the *Self-filing Setup Instructions* tab of this guide.
 - **Agent-filers:** Start at the *Agent-filing Setup Instructions* tab of this guide.

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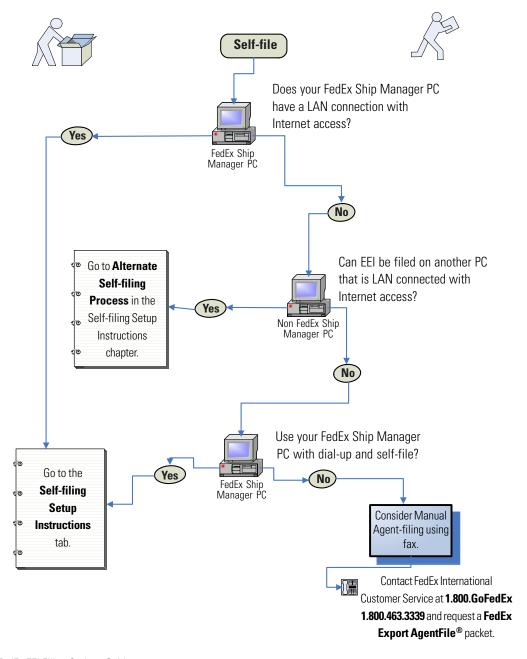
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If you want to self-file your EEI, START HERE and follow this flowchart.



Recommended Self-filing Process

AES Direct WebLink

With FedEx Ship Manager Software, you can conveniently self-file an EEI from the AES *Direct* WebLink on the Customs screen while you create a label for your shipment. AES Direct verifies EEI data and sends you the Internal Transaction Number (ITN) through email to complete your shipment.

Registration

Complete the online registration at www.aesdirect.gov several days before filing your first EEI. Allow 24 to 48 hours to receive your user name and password, although you may receive it sooner. Refer to following AESDirect Registration section for more information

Please check with your Export Compliance Department before registering with AES Direct.

User Name and Password

To self-file an EEI, use your pre-registered AESDirect user name and password and a valid email address. Go to the AESDirect website at www.aesdirect.gov for information about user names and passwords.

Regulatory Expertise

To be an EEI self-filer, you must pass the AES online test and maintain regulatory expertise required by the U.S. government.

Need to File Now?

If you need to file an EEI before you receive your user name and password, you can file your EEI using FedEx Export AgentFile from the FedEx website at fedex.com/eei



AES Direct Registration

Follow these steps to register with AES*Direct*.

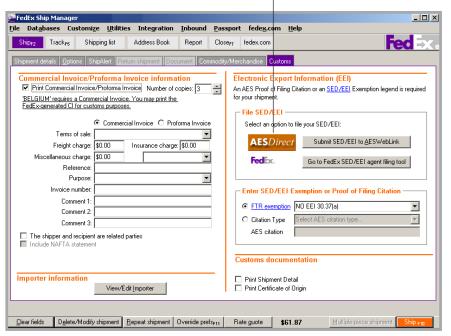
- Log in to www.aesdirect.gov then download and install the tutorial.
- Click Register New Account, complete the online form and submit AES Direct Registration.
- The Account Administrator identified on the registration form is notified by email that your company's registration has been received and is being processed. When the account has been set up, the Account Administrator receives the user name, password and an administrator code by email.

Once you receive your password, you can log in to the AESDirect website from the FedEx Ship Manager Software Customs screen or from the AFSDirect website at www.aesdirect.gov.

Adobe® Reader®

If your system does not have Adobe Reader, you can download Adobe Reader along with the tutorial. Having Adobe Reader will help you print copies of completed EEI records.

Alternate Self-filing Process

Self-file with AES Direct

Some FedEx Ship Manager Software customers using a dial-up connection experience problems connecting with AESDirect. Two options are

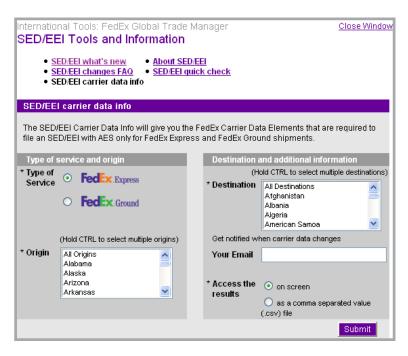
- Consider installing FedEx Ship Manager Software on another PC with a LAN connection. If you would like a copy of the software, go to **fedex.com** or contact your International Sales Professional.
- Use another PC (with a LAN connection) to file an EEI with AES Direct outside of FedEx Ship Manager Software. Note that this process requires duplicate data entry: once for AESDirect and again in FedEx Ship Manager Software. Go to www.aesdirect.gov to file directly with AESDirect.

Carrier Data Elements

Carrier data elements are required when filing your EEI with AES Direct outside of FedEx Ship Manager Software.

For easy access to carrier data elements from the FedEx Export AgentFile website, follow these steps:

- Go to **fedex.com/us/eei**. The FedEx International Tools screen displays.
- Click the **EEI Carrier Data Info** link on the left. The SFD/FFI carrier data info screen displays.
- Provide the required information, select the output for your results and click **Submit**.



Notes

Self-filing Instructions

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Step 1: Enter Shipment Information

Begin entering shipment information on your FedEx Ship Manager Software screen.

- Complete the Shipment details screen.
- 2 Click the **Options** tab and select any special services you want to include for your shipment.
- Click the **ShipAlert** tab to select shipment and delivery notifications if you want to send and receive email notifications.

Click the Commodity/Merchandise tab and enter detailed information for each commodity.

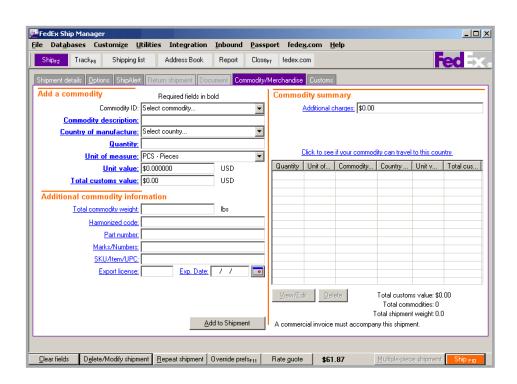
After you enter details, click Add to **Shipment** to add each commodity.

Include AES Direct Required Fields

- · Total commodity weight
- Harmonized code

Unit of Measure

If the unit of measure for your commodity is Each, select PCS - Pieces instead.



Step 1: Enter Shipment Information

- Click the **Customs** tab and review the options on the left side of the screen. including the Commercial/Proforma Invoice and the Importer Information.
- Select the options applicable to your shipment.
- To self-file the EEL click **Submit SED/EEL** to AESWebLink in the File SED/EEI section. The background color on your screen changes to orange while FedEx Ship Manager Software connects to AES Direct. Once connected, FedEx Ship Manager Software sends shipment information and commodity details to the AESDirect WebLink, so there is no duplicate data entry.

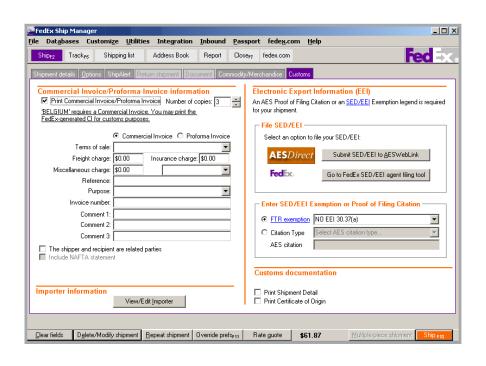
It takes a few seconds to a few minutes to connect to AES Direct. If you experience connection problems, call the FedEx Ship Manager Software Technical Support hotline at 1.877.339.2774

Weight and Currency Requirements

AES requires the commodity weight in kilograms. Pounds are converted to kilograms when the information is submitted to AES.

AES requires whole dollars only. Cents are removed when the information is submitted to AFS

In either case, no changes occur to your information within FedEx Ship Manager Software.



Step 2: Send Information to AES Direct

Complete the information requested on the AFS Direct website

- Enter your AESDirect user name and password then click **OK**.
- 2 Follow the instructions on the AESDirect website to complete the EEI filing.
- When you finish entering the data required for the AESDirect system, click Check and **Send**. If there are no errors, your shipment is submitted, and a message displays confirming that AES Direct has received your EEI record.
- AES issues the ITN once it has approved the shipment for export. The ITN is generally returned by email to the registered user of AES Direct.

The ITN begins with **AES** followed by **X** plus the approval date (YYYYMMDD format) and 6 numeric digits.

For example: AES X20080902456789.

Place a Shipment in Hold File

If you need to continue processing other shipments while waiting for your ITN, you can place the shipment in the Hold File.

Enable Hold File

If the Hold File checkbox does not display on the Shipment details screen in the Recipient information section, you must enable it.

- Select **System Settings** from the Customize drop-down men.
- 2 Select the System # and click **Modify**.
- 3 Click the 2-FedEx Customer Admin tab.
- Select **Enable Hold File** in the Shipping Screen section
- 5 Click **OK** then click **Close**

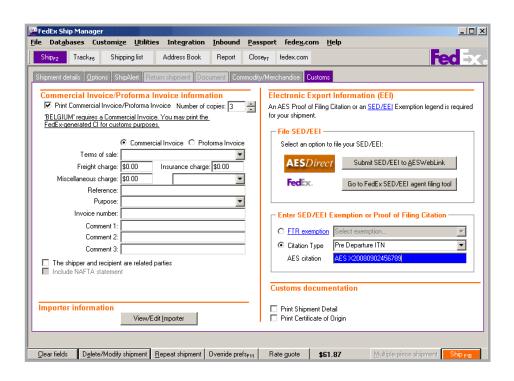
Put the Shipment on Hold

- Return to the Shipment details screen and check **Hold** in the Recipient information section.
- 2 Click **Hold** at the bottom of the screen.
- 3 To retrieve the shipment, select **Hold File** from the Shipping list tab.
- Select the shipment and click **Edit**.
- 5 Click the **Customs** tab and continue with step 2 on the next page.

Step 3: Finish Your Shipment

Return to FedEx Ship Manager Software to finish your shipment and print the label.

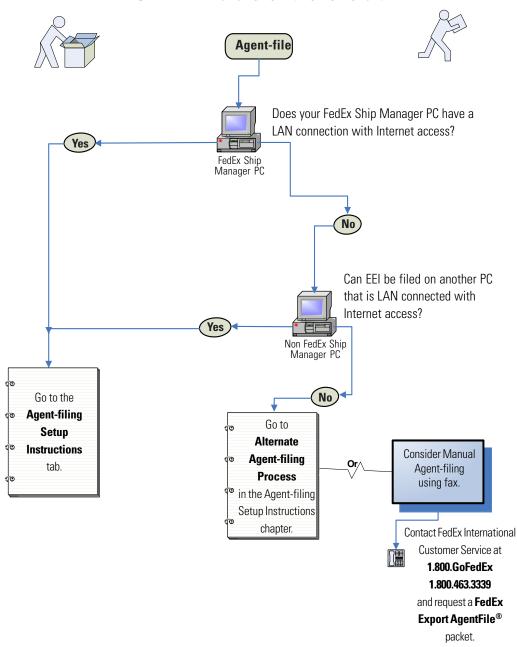
- Click the Ship button at the top of the screen to return to the Customs screen.
- 2 Enter the ITN as follows:
 - Click **Citation Type** in the Enter SED/ EEI Exemption or Proof of Filing Citation section.
 - Select Predeparture ITN from the drop-down menu.
 - Enter the ITN in the AES citation field.
- 3 Click **Ship** at the bottom of the screen to process the shipment.



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If you want to authorize FedEx as your agent to file your EEI, START HERE and follow this flowchart.



Recommended Agent-filing Process

FedEx Export AgentFile

FedEx Export AgentFile is the recommended tool for agent-filing and is integrated with FedEx Ship Manager Software. Use this tool when you want FedEx to file an EEI as your agent, and provide the EEI information on our FedEx Export AgentFile website.

After you provide us with EEI data and FedEx files the EEI, you can easily print the label by downloading the EEI data into FedEx Ship Manager Software.

Eliqible Shipments

Only FedEx Express EEI shipments are eligible for online agent-filing.

FedEx Export AgentFile Benefits

- · Look up Schedule B commodity codes and descriptions.
- View EEI filing activities for the past 45 days.
- Import shipping information from FedEx Export AgentFile to your FedEx Ship Manager Software shipping screen.
- Save names and addresses in the FedEx Export AgentFile address book for future use.
- Create product profiles in FedEx Export AgentFile to save commodity details for future use.

Manual Backup Process

If you cannot file your EEI using FedEx Export AgentFile, use the manual agent-filing process as a backup. Contact FedEx International Customer Service at 1.800.GoFedEx 1.800.463.3339 and request a FedEx Export AgentFile packet.

Do this first

Agent-filing Setup Instructions

Before using FedEx Export AgentFile, complete the setup instructions. Each user should create their own user ID and nassword

Step 1: FedEx Online Login Registration

Complete the one time only registration to create a user ID and password and to establish contact information

Step 2: FedEx Shipping Profile

Build a shipping profile on FedEx Export AgentFile, and identify the shipping system that will receive EEI data when you ship your packages.

Then continue

Agent-filing Instructions

After you complete the setup instructions, follow this two-step process to submit EEL data and ship your package.

Step 1: Enter and file EEI Data

Enter and file EEI data using FedEx Export AgentFile.

Step 2: Download EEI Data

Import EEI data from FedEx Export AgentFile into FedEx Ship Manager Software when you ship your package.

Registered fedex.com Users

If you already have a **fedex.com** user ID and password, follow these steps:

- Go to fedex.com/eei.
- Log in with your fedex.com user ID and password.
- Follow the instructions for setting up a FedEx shipping profile in Step 2: FedEx Shipping Profile.

Browser Requirement

If you are not using shipping hardware supplied by FedEx to enter EEI data, Internet Explorer version 6.0 is recommended.

New fedex.com Users

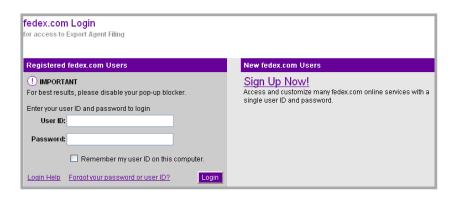
If you are not currently registered as a fedex.com user, you need your FedEx account number, the company name and address for your account number and your FedEx Ship Manager Software PC meter number/system ID to register.

- Go to fedex.com/eei.
- Click Sign Up Now! and follow the registration instructions on the following pages.

Security Alert

A Security Alert or Security Information window may display while registering for your login. To proceed, click **OK** or **Yes** when prompted.

Secure/Unsecure messages are due to your browser security settings. Using the Back button during these processes is not recommended.



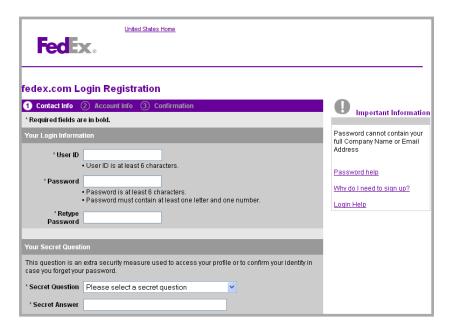
Contact Information

Your Login Information

- Enter a user ID with at least 6 characters.
- Enter a password with at least 6 characters. Your password must include at least one letter and one number. It cannot contain your full company name or email address.
- Retype your password for confirmation.

Your Secret Question

- Select a secret question, such as your mother's first name.
- Enter your secret answer.



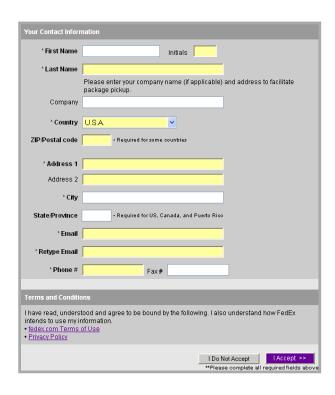
Contact Information

Your Contact Information

- Enter your first name, initials and last name.
- Enter your company name and address information.
 - Important: Your company name and address must match your FedEx account information on file with FedEx
- Enter your email address once. Then retype your email address for confirmation.
- Enter your phone number. Do not include dashes, spaces or other special characters.

Terms and Conditions

- Click fedex.com Terms of Use and read the explanation. Close this window to continue.
- 2 Click Privacy Policy and read the explanation. Close this window to continue.
- Click I Accept to agree to the Terms and Conditions
- Click I Do Not Accept if you do not agree to the Terms and Conditions
- If there are any discrepancies in the contact information, reenter the information requested on your screen. Then enter the Account Information on the following page.



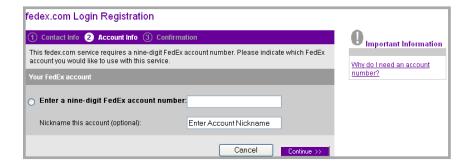

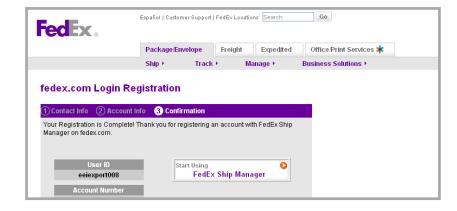
- Enter the 9-digit FedEx U.S.-based payor account number you want to use.
- Enter an account nickname that identifies the computer where you ship packages with FedEx Ship Manager Software.
- 3 Click Continue.

Confirmation

The Confirmation screen displays when your registration is complete. Please note your fedex.com user ID.

Continue on the next page to set up a shipping profile.





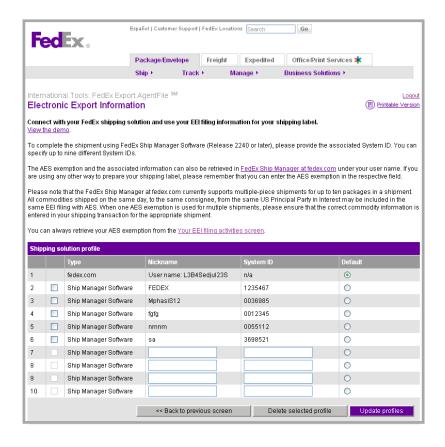
Step 2: FedEx Shipping Profile

Create a Shipping Profile

Scroll down to the Shipping solution profile section.

- In the Nickname column, enter a nickname that is easy to recognize, for example "Intl Shipping."
 - Your nickname/user name cannot be the same as the user name that displays on your screen.
- In the System ID column, enter the FedEx Ship Manager Software system ID or meter number of the computer you will use to complete the shipment.

- The system ID or meter number should be a FedEx Ship Manager Software system using v. 2358 or higher.
- Repeat this process for each FedEx Ship Manager Software system you want to use with FedEx Export AgentFile.
- Click the **Default** radial button for the shipping solution profile that you use most often.
- Click **Update profiles**. Your shipping solution profile(s) will be updated and the same screen will display.



Alternate Agent-filing Process

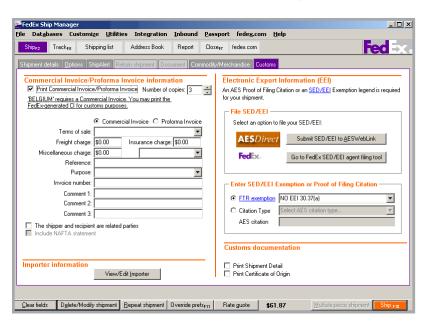
Agent-file from FedEx Ship Manager Software

Although FedEx recommends that most exporters start at FedEx Export AgentFile and enter EEI data there, some customers may see a benefit from entering EEI shipment data in FedEx Ship Manager Software and transferring data to FedEx Export AgentFile. For example:

- Customers whose FedEx Ship Manager Software computers only have a dial-up connection to the Internet
- Integrated customers who do not use the FedEx Export AgentFile XML solution.

If you choose this process

- Update your FedEx Ship Manager Software settings to support agent-filing and display the Get SED/EEI Data button on the shipping screen. Refer to Step 2: Download EEI Data in the following Agent-filing Instructions chapter. Once you have modified your system settings, you will be able to select Go to FedEx SED/EEI agent filing tool on the Customs screen.
- 2 Enter your shipment data as you would any international shipment.
- When prompted for an SED/EEI, select the Customs tab.
- In the Electronic Export Information (EEI) section, click Go to FedEx SED/EEI agent filing tool.



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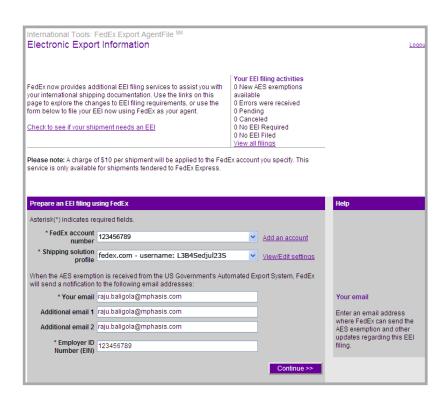
Log in to FedEx Export AgentFile

- Go to fedex.com/eei
- Enter your fedex.com user ID and password.
- Select the FedEx account number for billing the EEI filing charge.
- Select the shipping solution profile for your FedEx Ship Manager Software system. This is where the EEI filing information and the ITN are available after the EEI is filed.

Enter the email address where you want FedEx to send the AES Proof of Filing citation and other EEI filing information. You may enter up to 2 additional emails.

Helpful Hint

Bookmark the FedEx Export AgentFile website and name it **EEI Start** so you will always know to start here when you have an international shipment that requires an EEI.



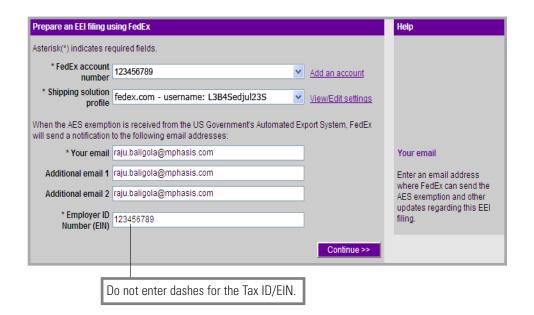
Log in to FedEx Export AgentFile

- Select Employer ID number (EIN) as the Tax ID/EIN type for the U.S. Principal Party in Interest (USPPI).
- Enter the IRS EIN of the USPPI as the Tax ID/EIN if an EIN has not been assigned. Be sure not to include dashes.

Steps 3-7 are performed on initial setup. When you subsequently log in, the data you entered will display and you can simply click **Continue** to enter your shipment data. **Important:** When you finish this screen and click **Continue**, you can change the shipping profile that will receive the ITN by editing the profile selection on the Shipment Details screen. Refer to Submit Information later in this section for more information

Obtain EIN

You can obtain an EIN by registering with the Internal Revenue Service (IRS). If you have any questions about EINs, please call the IRS at 1.800.829.4933.

Exporter USPPI Information

Exporter Profile

Enter the Exporter company name and additional required fields.

If you have previously entered an Exporter's profile, select Select Exporter from my Address Book from the drop-down menu. Then click **Click here** to open your address book in the Exporter profile help text on the right.

The exporter is usually the shipper and is also referred to as the U.S. Principal Party In Interest (USPPI). The shipper is not always the exporter. For clarification of Exporter or USPPI, please use the online help by rolling the cursor over the field name.

2 Manage My Address Book Entries

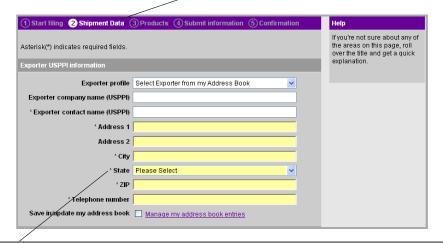
Click this link if you want to open and modify the address book. To access the site wide address book, you must log into fedex.com again. This is a security feature.

The address book on fedex.com is separate from your FedEx Ship Manager Software address book.

Save in/Update My Address Book

Check this option if you want to save the exporter's information in the address book on the FedEx website

There are 5 steps to entering EEI information. The current step is highlighted.



State Shipments from the U.S. to Puerto Rico require **PR** in the State/Province field and **U.S.** in the country field. Shipments from the U.S. and Puerto Rico to Mexico require a state code in the State/Province field. Refer to Mexican States and Codes in the Additional Information chapter.

Shipment Data

Ultimate Consignee Information

The ultimate consignee is the final recipient of the shipment.

Ultimate Consignee

Scroll down to see the Ultimate Consignee section and select the consignee company from the drop-down menu.

If the consignee company is not in the address book, you can add the consignee to the address book while you complete the consignee information on your screen.

2 Add Consignee to the Address Book:

- Select Add a new contact name and enter the consignee name.
- Complete the consignee information.

3 Save in/Update My Address Book

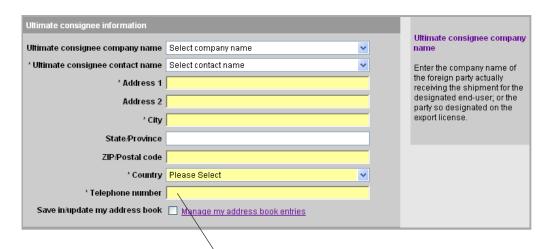
Check this option to save new and modified consignee information.

Manage My Address Book Entries

Click this link to open and modify the address book as needed.

Helpful Hint

The first time you process an EEI to an ultimate consignee, select a consignee from your address book or add a consignee by using the drop-down menu.



Enter a valid international telephone number without dashes, spaces or other special characters. Enter a minimum of eight digits and a maximum of 13 digits.

Shipment Data

Additional Information

Intermediate Consignee

Select **Yes** if a party in a foreign country will deliver the contents of the shipment to the ultimate consignee or the party named on the export license. If not, select No.

Please note that FedEx is not the Intermediate Consignee.

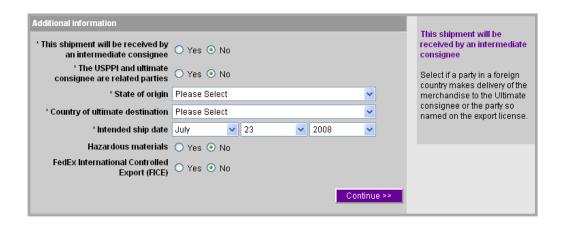
Related parties

Select Yes if the USPPI and the ultimate consignee are related, such as subsidiaries or holding companies. If not, select No.

3 State of Origin

The state of origin fills in from the Export USPPI state field. It should meet one of these criteria. Choose the state in which:

- The merchandise actually starts its journey to the port of export.
- The commodity that has the highest value originates.
- The commodities are consolidated.
- 4 Enter the Country of ultimate destination.
- 5 Enter the Intended ship date.
- Select **Yes** or **No** for Hazardous Materials. 6

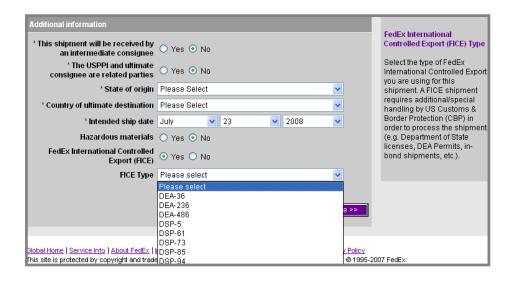
FedEx International Controlled Export

If the shipment is not a FedEx International Controlled Export (FICE) shipment, select No and proceed to step 8.

If the shipment is an FICE shipment, click **Yes**. The FICE Type field displays.

Select the FICE type for your shipment from the drop-down menu.

Click Continue at the bottom of the screen

Product Profile

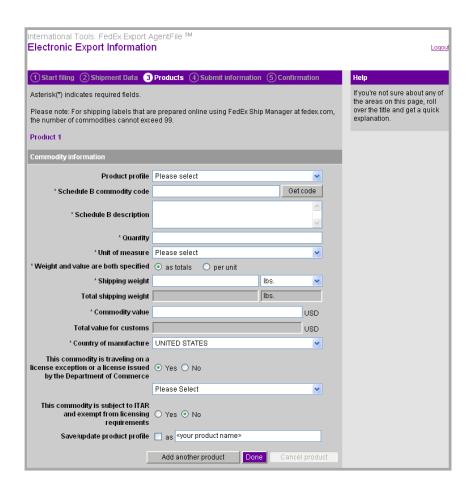
Select a product profile from the dropdown menu. If you do not have a profile for this type of commodity, follow the instructions starting on the next page.

Be sure to save the product by selecting the Save/update product profile checkbox and entering a name for the profile.

Helpful Hint

A product profile in FedEx Export AgentFile is similar to the commodity database function in FedEx Ship Manager Software. As you build your product profiles, save the profile to streamline future EEI filings.

Remember: To save product profiles, ensure that you have a **fedex.com** shipping profile.



Products

Schedule B Commodity Code

- Click Get code.
- Enter the code or description that is available, such as the first 5 digits of the code
- Click Search

Note: Only click Search one time. There may be a slight delay before the results display.

Schedule B Commodity Description

When you receive the code results, click the appropriate Schedule B code to automatically populate the Schedule B description, Schedule B commodity code and Unit of Measure

Quantity

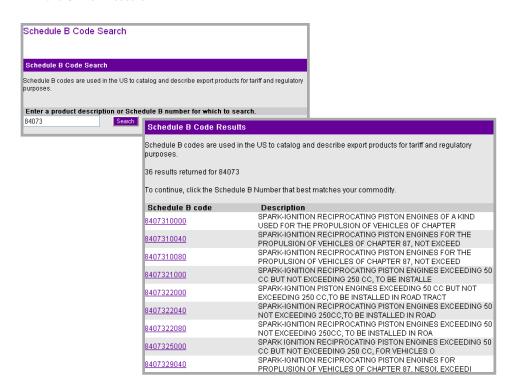
Specify the total number of units you are shipping of this commodity. The number of units should correspond to the unit of measure, such as 1 dozen or 5 liters.

Unit of Measure 5

Unit of Measure is filled in from the Schedule B lookup.

Did You Know?

Shipment delays result from customs stopping a shipment because the commodity description does not match the Schedule B code. This lookup tool eliminates the risks of those delays!



Products

Weight and Value radial buttons

Indicate whether the weight and value for this commodity is provided as a total for this shipment or on a per unit basis.

If you select the **as totals** radial button, the product profile is saved as per unit when the shipment weight is converted from lbs to kgs.

Shipment Weight

Enter the gross shipping weight for this commodity, including the weight of the packaging. Then select the weight type.

If you select **lbs** as the weight type, the shipment weight is converted to kgs when the shipment is submitted for EEI filing. It is also saved in the product profile as kgs.

8 **Commodity Value**

Enter the selling price or cost (if not sold), including freight, insurance and other charges to U.S. port of export, excluding unconditional discounts and commissions

Note: Enter the value in whole dollars only.

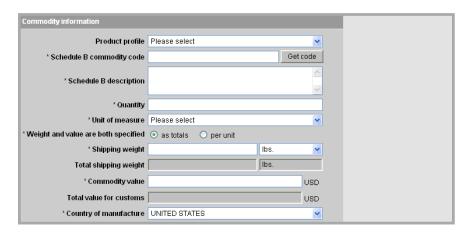
Total Value for Customs

Confirm that the Total value for customs is correct. If this field is not correct, you can adjust your entries in the Quantity or Commodity value fields, or you can select an alternate choice for as totals/per unit in the Weight and value are both specified fields

10 Country of Manufacture

Select the country where the commodity was originally produced or manufactured.

Since AES only needs to know if the commodities/products were domesticmade or foreign-made, it does not require specific country of manufacture information. For multiple commodities/ products, enter the most predominant country of manufacture. FedEx Export AgentFile converts it to the appropriate designation when submitting to AES.

11 License Exception

Since most shipments are usually under a license exception, no license required indicator or on a Commerce license, the default selection is Yes.

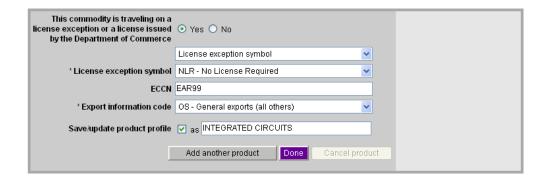
For example, Yes is appropriate if the commodity is traveling:

- Under the No License Required (NLR) designator.
- On a type of license exception.
- On a license issued by the Department of Commerce, Bureau of Industry and Security (BIS).

If Yes is not correct, select **No**.

12 Complete the ECCN and Export Information code.

The sample screen below shows a typical shipment where the license exception is the NLR indicator and EAR99, which indicates items are subject to the Export Administration Regulations (EAR) but not listed on the Commerce Control List (CCL). The Export Information Code of OS-General Exports is what most commodities fall under.

13 ITAR Exemption

If the commodity is subject to the International Traffic in Arms Regulations (ITAR) but does not require a Department of State license, an ITAR exemption citation from the regulations is required.

If you click **Yes**, additional required fields display.

14 If your shipment includes additional commodities, click Add another product and complete the commodity details.

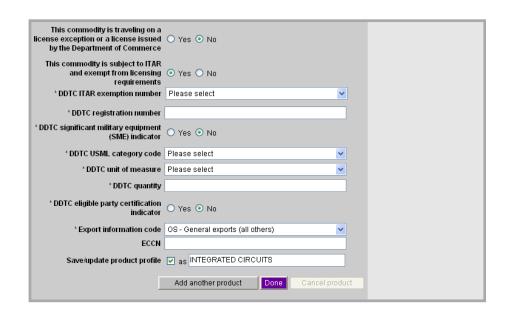
15 Save/Update Product Profile

Check Save/update product profile to save new or modified profiles.

16 When you finish entering product profiles for the shipment, click **Done**.

Helpful Hint

Enter all commodities for the shipment. Commodity information can be passed to FedEx Ship Manager Software so you do not have to enter it twice.



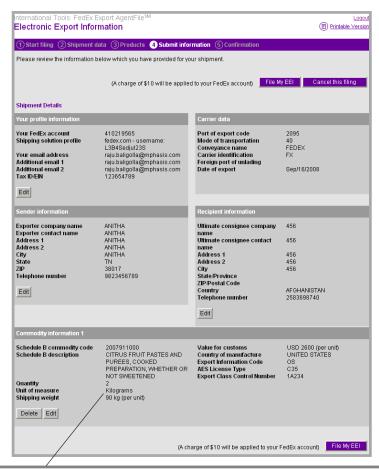
Submit Information

- Review your shipment details before submitting the EEI for FedEx to file.
- 2 To modify information, click **Edit** and enter your changes in the applicable section.
- To delete a commodity, click **Delete**.
- If you do not want to submit the shipment contents, click Cancel this filing at the bottom of the screen.

To submit the data to FedEx so that FedEx files the EEI for you, click File My EEI.



If you do not click File My EEI, your filing process is stopped.

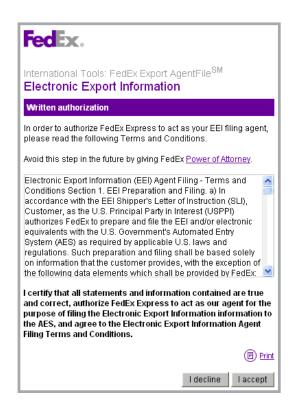

Written Authorization

Next, authorize FedEx Express to act as your EEI filing agent.

- Read the EEI Agent Filing Terms and Conditions on your screen then click I accept. The Confirmation screen displays.
- If you do not agree to the Terms and Conditions, click I decline. You return to the FedEx Export AgentFile homepage, and all shipment data is lost for this shipment.



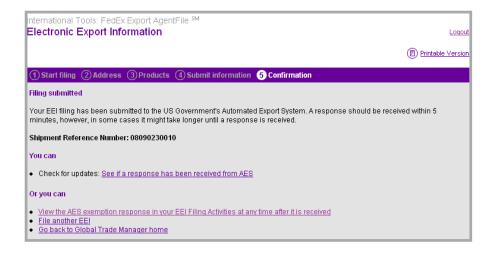
Confirmation

The Confirmation screen confirms that your EEI filing has been submitted to the U.S. Government's Automated Export System (AES).

- Note the Shipment Reference Number (SRN) for future reference.
- If you have additional EEIs to file, click File another EEL
- Continue on the following page of this guide to receive the ITN for your shipment.

From the Confirmation screen, you can:

- Check for updates.
- View your EEI Filing Activities.
- File another EEI.
- Go back to Global Trade Manager home.



View EEI Filing Activities

- To view the status of the EEL click the **View** the AES exemption response in your **EEI Filing Activities at any time after** it is received link at the bottom of the Confirmation screen.
- Check the status of an EEI that you have already submitted by looking under the Status/AES exemption number column.
- If you have completed filing your EEIs and have received an ITN for each EEI filed, proceed to Step 2: Download EEI Data.

EEIs Filed in the Past 45 Days

The Your EEI filing activities screen displays EEIs filed within the past 45 days.

The status of the filing appears in the Status/AES exemption number column. If an ITN has been assigned, the ITN displays in the Status column.





Review Filing Status

You can cancel or modify an EEI filing from the Your EEI filing activities screen.

- Click the radial button to select the entry.
- To cancel the filing, click **Cancel This** Filing.

Errors Received

If the status is Errors Received, click Errors **Received.** Review the error(s), make corrections and resubmit the filing.

Pending Status

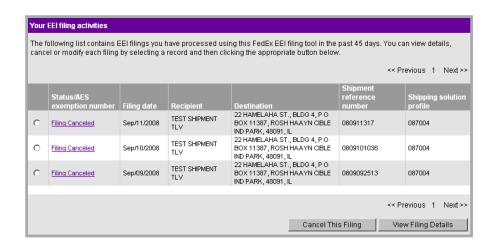
To receive the latest status from AES, click your browser refresh icon to refresh the screen.

If you have been in Pending status for 15 minutes, call FedEx International Customer Service at 1.800.GoFedEx 1.800.463.3339.

When you call, have your shipment reference number available. Inform the agent that you are using the FedEx Export AgentFile EEI process and that you need to check the status of an EEI filing.

A Pending status may mean one of the following:

- Delay in AES processing.
- Data error that needs your correction before submitting to AES.
- FedEx is correcting data errors before submitting to AES.
- Denied or restricted party screening is in process.
- Record was corrected but File My SED was not clicked



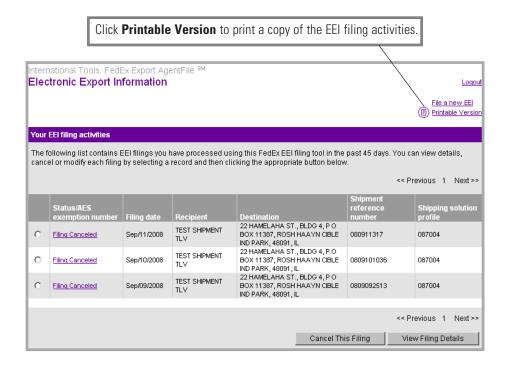
Print EEI Filing Information

It is recommended that you print a copy of your EEI filing. To print a copy, follow these steps:

- Click the radial button.
- 2 Click View Filing Details.
- Click Printable Version located in the upper right of the screen.
- Click the browser printer icon.

FedEx Export AgentFile displays information for all EEIs filed in the past 45 days. There is an additional charge if you request a report of EEI data older than 45 days. Please retain a copy for your records before the 45-day deadline.

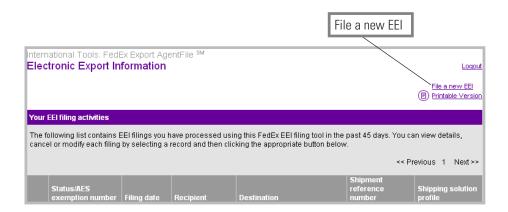

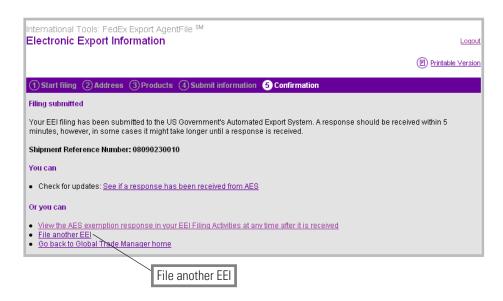

FedEx Ship Manager Software Settings

FedEx Export AgentFile works seamlessly with FedEx Ship Manager Software by downloading the EEI needed for your shipment.

To download information, first you must update the FedEx Ship Manager Software settings. You only need to do this once.

If you are logged into FedEx Ship Manager Software, click the **Ship** button at the top of the screen. If not, launch FedEx Ship Manager Software.

- Select your system number and click Modify.

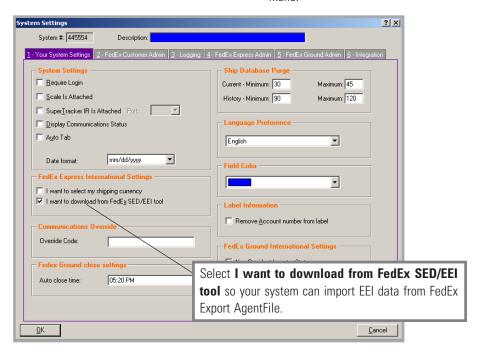

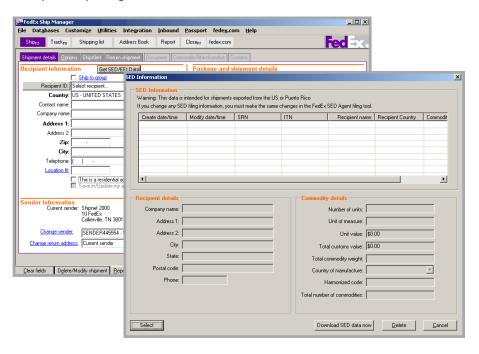
Import EEI Data

Once the Get SED/EEI Data button displays on your FedEx Ship Manager Software screen and the ITN is ready to download from FedEx Export AgentFile, you are ready to print the shipping label.

Follow these steps to import the ITN and all shipment information to FedEx Ship Manager Software.

- Click the Get SED/EEI Data button on the Shipment details screen.
- If the ITN appears on the SED Information screen, highlight the ITN and click **Select**. Then go to step 5.
- If the ITN does not appear on the SED Information screen, click **Download SED** data now. If you receive a message stating no information is available, your EEI record may still be pending.

- Highlight the ITN on the SED Information screen and click Select.
- Select the Service type and enter the remaining information that was not downloaded to your shipping screen.
- Enter the Bill Duties/Taxes information when prompted.
- If a date displays in the License Expiration date field and the shipment does not require a license, delete this date.
- Click **Ship** to complete your shipment.

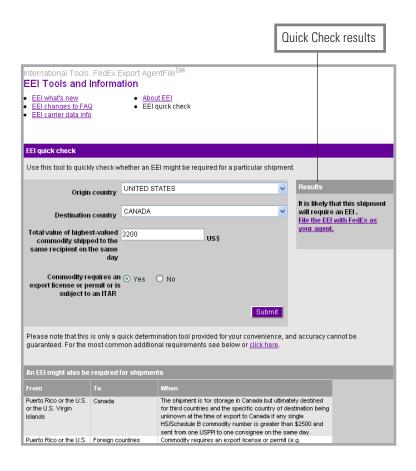

- Note that if you are not logged in to FedEx Export AgentFile, enter your user ID and password, then click Check to see if your shipment needs an EEI to access the EEI Quick Check tool.
- Complete the information and click **Submit**. The results display on the right.
