



**Updated Feb. 12, 2021**

We announced a surcharge on all FedEx Express® and TNT international parcel and freight shipments beginning April 6, 2020.

We implemented this surcharge due to the various COVID-19 containment restrictions issued in countries around the world. Those restrictions are disrupting the global supply chain. As a result, air cargo capacity is limited, and we are incurring incremental costs as we adjust our international networks to best deliver much-needed goods and services in this constrained environment.

Beginning Feb. 15, 2021, the surcharge for parcel and freight shipments originating in the U.S. and destined for the European region will increase, except for the countries listed below. The surcharge for the following countries will remain \$0.10 per pound (\$0.22 per kilogram).
