## Thanksgiving

### Wednesday, November 27, 2019

- Early on-call pickups in some areas for FedEx Express
- FedEx Office will close by 6 p.m.

### Thursday, November 28, 2019

- FedEx Express, FedEx Ground, FedEx Home Delivery<sup>®</sup>, FedEx SmartPost<sup>®</sup>, FedEx Freight, and FedEx Office unavailable<sup>2</sup>
- Per Money-Back Guarantee section of the [FedEx Service Guide](#), shipments scheduled for delivery on a holiday will be delivered the next business day

### Friday, November 29, 2019

- Early on-call, adjusted regular pickups, and drop box closings in some areas for FedEx Express
- FedEx Freight unavailable

### Saturday, November 30, 2019

- Early on-call pickups in some areas for FedEx Express
- FedEx Ground and FedEx Freight unavailable

## Christmas

### Monday, December 16, 2019

- FedEx Freight no-fee, money-back guarantee suspended for shipments with required delivery dates of Monday, December 16, 2019, through Thursday, January 2, 2020

### Saturday, December 21, 2019

- No pickups for FedEx SmartPost but deliveries will be made as usual
- FedEx Ground and FedEx Freight unavailable

### Sunday, December 22, 2019

- FedEx Express, FedEx Ground, FedEx Home Delivery, FedEx SmartPost, and FedEx Freight unavailable<sup>2</sup>

### Monday, December 23, 2019

- FedEx Freight will be open with normal pickup and delivery operations and a modified linehaul schedule. Shipments picked up that are not moved will resume transit on December 26, 2019.

### Tuesday, December 24, 2019

- FedEx Express will have early station, on-call pickup, and drop box closings in some areas
- FedEx Office will close by 6 p.m.
- FedEx Freight unavailable

### Wednesday, December 25, 2019

- FedEx Express, FedEx Ground, FedEx Home Delivery, FedEx SmartPost, FedEx Freight, and FedEx Office unavailable<sup>2</sup>

## New Year's

### Saturday, December 28, 2019

- FedEx Ground, FedEx SmartPost, and FedEx Freight unavailable

### Sunday, December 29, 2019

- FedEx Express, FedEx Ground, FedEx Home Delivery, FedEx SmartPost, and FedEx Freight unavailable<sup>2</sup>

### Tuesday, December 31, 2019

- FedEx Express will have early on-call and drop box pickups in some areas
- FedEx Office will close by 6 p.m.
- FedEx Freight will be open with only prearranged pickup and delivery shipments being made. FedEx Freight<sup>®</sup> shipments picked up on December 31, 2019, will resume on January 2, 2020. For example, a one-day shipment picked up on December 31, 2019, will resume on January 2, 2020, and deliver on January 3, 2020.

### Wednesday, January 1, 2020

- FedEx Express, FedEx Ground, FedEx Home Delivery, FedEx SmartPost, FedEx Freight, and FedEx Office unavailable<sup>2</sup>

## Money-Back Guarantee Suspension for the 2019 Holiday Season

### Wednesday, November 27, 2019

- The FedEx Money-Back Guarantee for FedEx Express will be suspended for packages scheduled for delivery on this date if the delivery was made within 90 minutes of the delivery commitment for the selected service and destination!

### Monday, December 2–Tuesday, December 24, 2019

- The FedEx Money-Back Guarantee for FedEx Ground and FedEx Home Delivery will be suspended for packages picked up between these dates!

### Wednesday, December 18–Tuesday, December 24, 2019

- The FedEx Money-Back Guarantee for FedEx Express will be suspended for packages scheduled for delivery between these dates that were delivered by the end of the day on the published delivery commitment date for the selected service and destination!
