


Freight shipping can open up new doors for your business — even if you don't have time to classify each item. Our freight box makes transporting less-than-truckload (LTL) shipments simple, with improved flexibility, increased security, and best of all, no freight classification.

You can find end-to-end rate quotes for the FedEx Freight box quickly and accurately with the **Get Rates & Transit Times** tool. Whatever you're shipping, this tool can help you compare rates and transit times to make an informed decision about your freight.

Before you start, please note: FedEx Freight box requires a separate account and pricing. For help signing up, contact your FedEx account executive.


How It Works

1. Go to fedex.com. Log in (if you haven't already) and click the Shipping tab on the main page.





2. On the Shipping tab, click the Create a Shipment link.




3. On the FedEx Ship Manager® page, Select the LTL Freight tab.

In the **Account Information** section, select your freight box account from the **Select an account** dropdown list. (Note: if you do not see your **Freight Box** account in the dropdown list, you will need to add your account.)

Remember: FedEx Freight box requires a separate account and pricing. For help signing up, contact your FedEx account executive.

For help adding your Freight Box account to the drop down menu (highlighted) and adding an authorized user Freight tech support at 1.800.435.7949.

You can add authorized users to your account by following the steps on the Administration tab.




- **4.** Confirm that the **Payment type/terms** are correct. To change payment type or terms, click the **Edit** link to expand the options.
 - If the shipment is coming from you, select **Shipper** next to **Payment type** and select **Prepaid** next to **Payment terms**.
 - If the shipment is coming **to** you, select **Consignee** next to **Payment type**, select **Collect** next to **Payment terms** and enter the appropriate information in the **From** fields. (The **To** fields in Step 5 will auto-populate from your account information, but you can change them later if needed.)

Note: Whether you're the shipper or the consignee, you must have an account with FedEx Freight Box options before initiating a shipment to ensure the correct pricing is applied.



- **5.** When using **Shipper/Prepaid** options, the **From** fields will auto-populate from your account information.
- **6.** In the **To** section, choose **United States** from the **Country/Location** dropdown. Then enter the contact information and address of your shipment's destination. The information can be saved into your address book for future use.



7. In the **Service Type and Guarantees** section, choose the **Service type** that matches the rate quote you selected on the previous page.




8. In the **Shipment Details** section, enter the Description, Hazmat¹, number of **Handling units²** you're shipping and be sure to select **Pallet/Skid** as the packaging type, pieces (number of Freight Boxes), enter the Total weight³, Class, Dimensions of your Freight Box and the NMFC.

For more than one handling unit: Select Add handling unit, and another row will appear to enter information for another box/handling unit.


• You do not have to know or submit accurate weight and class information, but they're still required fields to generate a rate quote and process your shipment. Enter any number less than 1,200 in the **Weight** column. Select any **Class** from the dropdown. These fields will not affect your rate.

Notes about this section:


- ¹Hazardous materials cannot be shipped in the FedEx Freight box, and shipments containing hazardous materials cannot be created using your FedEx Freight box account.
- ²A **Handling Unit** is one item that can picked up by a forklift, which could be one Freight Box or two stacked and wrapped together (which would be two pieces)
- ³All freight box shipments are weighed to ensure that shipments comply with transportation safety regulations. The maximum weight limit is 1,200 lbs. Shipments over 1,200 lbs. will be charged list rates.




9. Check all the options that apply to your shipment in the **Additional Services** section. This helps us provide the most accurate rate quote possible. (These additional services are not discounted with freight box shipments.)



10. On the **Schedule Pickup** tab, you'll enter the shipping dates and times and contact information for the pick up contact




- **11.** On this section, you'll see a summary of the **Shipment Details** you entered on the previous page and a list of **Rates & Transit Times** to choose from. (These include FedEx Freight® Priority and FedEx Freight® Economy options.)
 - Click the Rate links or the + signs to expand the details of each rate quote.
- **12.** Choose your service and make a note of your selection. (You will have to re-enter your choice on the next page.) Click **Create Shipment**.




13. Confirm the information and Complete your Shipment.

Notes about this section:

- **Shipper's Bill of Lading** and **P.O. number** fields are optional. You can use them for your internal numbers, and they'll appear on your invoice for reference.
- Click Create a Shipment



14. Confirm any missing information in any **Required fields**. Here is an example.



15. You'll see a confirmation page with all the details of your shipment. If you checked **Prepare a BOL** or **Prepare Shipping Labels** on the previous page, you'll be able to download these documents from this page. If you're the consignee, you can then email the shipping label to the shipper. You'll also receive a shipment confirmation via email.
