



Completing the Power of Attorney (POA) for Electronic Export Information (EEI)

1) Purpose:

The purpose of the FedEx Express Power of Attorney to Transmit Electronic Export Information is to provide Federal Express Corporation (FedEx Express) with the authority to transmit EEI (formally referred to as SED) data on behalf of the U.S. Principal Party in Interest (USPPI) to the Automated Export System (AES) for U.S. Exports.

2) Instructions:

Complete the enclosed form, sign, date and send it to the email address below. At the bottom of the form, enter all applicable FedEx account numbers; use a separate sheet if necessary.

3) Definitions:

USPPI: United States Principal Party in Interest is the person or company in the U.S. that receives the primary benefit, monetary or otherwise, of the export transaction. Generally that person/company is the U.S. seller, manufacturer or order party.

4) Who can sign the Power of Attorney (POA) for EEI filing?

Only an officer of the corporation may sign the POA for EEI filing (e.g. secretary/treasurer of the corporation, controller, owner, partner, vice president or higher).

5) How to return the FedEx POA to FedEx Express:

6) What happens next:

Once we receive the POA for EEI filing, we will update the FedEx shipping systems and you will not have to authorize FedEx to be your agent for each electronic shipping transaction when an EEI is required. The update will generally be effective within 48 hours of receiving your letter.

The USPPI agrees to be bound by and liable for all statements of FedEx Express on behalf of USPPI based upon information or documentation provided by the USPPI to FedEx Express.

This power of attorney (POA) is to remain in full force and effect until revocation in writing is duly given by the USPPI or FedEx Express and received by the other party.
