Here are the highlights

A new package level special service option, DG (Dangerous Goods) by road is introduced as part of FedEx Ground® services, to permit intra-country Dangerous Goods shipments via road.

The global deferred air freight service, FedEx Deferred Freight (FDF) fills the delivery gap for air freight packages to fulfill end-to-end delivery service.

DG by Road shipments are available through FedEx Regional® Economy, and FedEx Express® domestics shipments options.

Enhance your label printing process with the latest high quality 300dpi Thermal Label support. As an alternative to regular 203 dpi resolution, this option offers clear print and cost-effective solution.

FedEx Express domestic services for Intra country shipments extends to South Africa and Chile.

Fuel surcharge expansion accommodates Dangerous Goods (DG), DG by Road (intra-Europe), and Address Correction surcharges will be included in the fuel surcharge calculations for all intra-country and international services.





The new product key expiration notification feature displays product key expiration date and uses a color change to indicate when it is time to upgrade.

The **Simplified Commodity Shipment** option allows for efficient processing of commodity shipments with **minimal commodity details**.

Commodity weight tag now supports up to three decimal values for accurate weight display.

A charge is assessed on U.S. import shipments in connection with the processing of those shipments for clearance.

Honduras, Portugal, and Vietnam are now direct serve countries/territories, and shipment efficiency is enhanced with local currency alternatives and rates.

International express packages meeting Additional Handling Surcharge (AHS) – Dimension criteria will be subject to a 40 lb (18 kg). minimum billable weight (MBW).
