FedEx Ship Manager 4050 adds support-assisted FedEx API registration, enhances FedEx International Direct Distribution workflows and shipment information, improves the Dynamic Rate Quote to identify qualifying FedEx One Rate® pricing, and updates FedEx Ground® Economy demand charge calculations.

FedEx Ship Manager aims to help accommodate all your logistic requirements and

facilitate a best-in-class shipping experience.

Before you begin

Installing FedEx Ship Manager® 4050

You must be running FedEx Ship Manager 32XX or higher to upgrade to 4050.

Before starting the installation of FedEx Ship Manager:

- Turn off any virus protection or firewall programs on your PC, these programs may interfere with the installation.
- Close all other open files and programs.

System and hardware recommendations and requirements

Recommendations:

- Intel® i5
- 8 GB RAM and 10 GB disk space
- 64-bit Desktop versions: Windows® 10, Windows® 10 Pro Windows®, 10 Enterprise, Windows® 11, Windows® Server 2016
- Available port if you are using thermal printer
- Laser and/or inkjet printer for reports and labels

Note: FSM 4050 uses Java 21. FSM includes a Java binary for its own use and does not install Java as a standard Windows application. You can't upgrade, patch, or replace the FSM Java runtime separately. FedEx delivers all Java updates through FSM software releases.

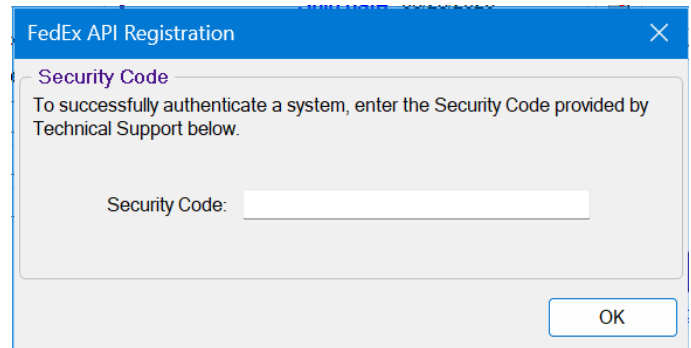
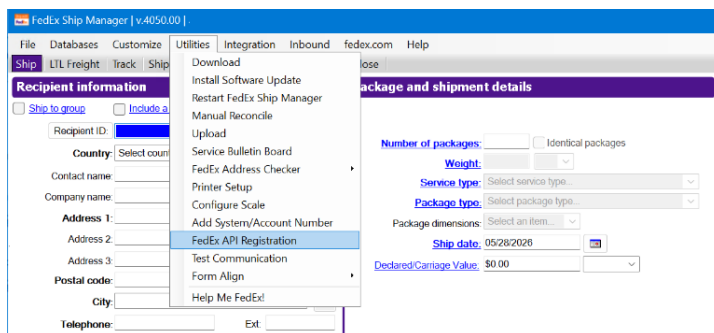
New and improved FedEx Ship Manager 4050 is here to assist you with your shipping requirements. The latest enhancements are designed to help provide a faster and more convenient shipping experience.

FedEx API Registration

When a system does not automatically authenticate with the backend services required for FedEx APIs, you can use **FedEx API Registration** window to complete registration manually.

The FedEx API Registration option is available from the **Utilities** menu on the main shipping screen. Use this option only when directed by FedEx Technical Support. A **security code** provided by Technical Support is required to complete registration.

Note: The FedEx API Registration option is only available in the Utilities menu if automatic authentication fails.



FedEx International Direct Distribution updates

There are several updates to the **FedEx International Direct Distribution (IDD)** workflow included in this version.

For certain Canada IDD shipments, a new **Shipment Summary Description** field is available on the IDD Master Shipment Information screen. This field is used when **XML Linehaul** is selected in **IDD Preferences** and an **ACE Portal Provider** is selected for the IDD master shipment. The field supports up to 512 characters and is required when these conditions apply.

Additional IDD updates include the following:

- The Shipment **Summary Description** field can be set in IDD Shipping Profile preferences using None, Constant, or Carry behavior.
- The **SCAC Code** and **Customs Submission** fields are now required when applicable.
- The separate Create CI and Create CCI options have been combined into one option: **Create Consolidated Commercial Invoice and**

Commercial Invoice.

- The minimum number of Commercial Invoice copies can now be set to 0.
- **Commercial Invoice and Consolidated Commercial Invoice** reports now include the full broker address.
- The current IDD master shipment is now shown in **bold** on the IDD Dashboard.
- The **Trip Number** field is now optional for Canadian shipments.
- When reports are modified from **IDD History** and **Apply** is selected, the reports are regenerated immediately and the **Last Modified Date** is updated.
- Commodity consolidation on the **IDD ACE Manifest Report** has been improved.
- Deleting a **Transborder Distribution** multiple-piece shipment now uses the same warning behavior as other multiple-piece shipments.

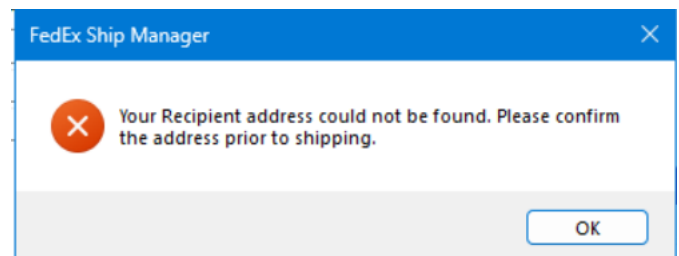
These updates help improve IDD data entry, reporting accuracy, and workflow clarity.

Address Checker message clarification

The **Address Checker** now provides clearer guidance when an address cannot be validated.

If the Address Checker cannot validate an address, the updated message advises users to confirm the address with the recipient before shipping.

The dialog has also been simplified to include a single **OK** button that returns users directly to the address entry fields, **making it easier to review and correct the information.**



FedEx One Rate Quote enhancement

When FedEx One Rate pricing applies, **One Rate** now appears next to the **Dynamic Rate Quote** on the Shipping screen. Selecting the Dynamic Rate Quote displays additional information confirming that the displayed amount reflects the lowest available FedEx One Rate price. **This enhancement provides greater transparency and confidence in the rate presented to the user.**
